- 2) News and Updates from GPO (Kate)
 - a. Tapella Appointment & H.R. 5305 status and GPO
 - i. Tapella former public printer
 - 1. Instrumental in title 44
 - 2. Some controversy in the past
 - 3. ARL and ALA might be working on commentary about the appointment
 - ii. HR 5305
 - 1. Introduced in to the House and referred to the House Committee on Administration
 - 2. Basically in limbo for now
 - b. New coordinators: David Schaffter (USAF Library) & Jen Leffler (UNC) (4 new coordinators in the past year)
 - c. Briefly looked over Nesis Uni (New interface Lexus Nexis)
- 3) Shared Trust Program (Karen)
 - a. This is retention/preservation agreement through the Colorado Alliance. This had been done with regular monographs, but now Mines is experimenting with doing it for Gov Docs. They are focusing on strong local collections.
 - b. The contract lasts for 25 years, and you do not have to commit the entire collection
 - c. Makes collection more visible
 - d. Now Mines is investigating becoming a Preservation Steward for the same collection emo's
- 4) Demo's
 - a. CQ Press U.S. Political Stats & PRS Researchers Dataset (Kate)
 - i. PRS good for poli sci, international affairs, etc.
 - Used to just be a spreadsheet in a lib guide. Now it's an online interface. People who need it know exactly what it's called. So if you receive a

question asking for PRS, country risk data sets, or Country data Online, contact CU Boulder

- 2. This is political risk data (Corruption, war and conflict, bureaucracy ratings, etc...)that goes mostly back to the 80's
- ii. U.S Political Stats
 - 1. By CQ press
 - 2. Stats from all three branches of the government. Lots of different data sets on everything from religious affiliation of congress to the "personal surrounding background" of Supreme Court justices.
 - 3. Most important? Floor votes for major legislation!
 - 4. All data can be downloaded
- b. MyHeritage.com (Mark)
 - i. Library version of ancestry.com
 - ii. Good for old census materials and also includes other types of contextual documents
- c. Mark showed off Kibosh (UNC libguides)
