Professional Internship/Research Project Policy and Guidelines

Introduction

Participation in a Professional Internship or Research Project is a requirement for CLASIC students to earn their degree. Participation will consist of an internship/research project agreement between a student and an industry partner or faculty member who will employ or supervise the student in a role that supports the academic goals of the internship/research project. Instructor participation will include facilitation of the final assessment of student performance as well as support for any academic-related issues that may arise during the internship/research project period.

Policies/Eligibility

- 1. The student is required to complete and sign the CLASIC Professional Internship or Research Project Agreement. This must be approved and signed by the industry partner/faculty member directing it and by the departmental academic advisor.
- 2. University policy states that only faculty members with appropriate graduate faculty appointment with the Graduate School may sponsor graduate Research Project credits.
- 3. (International students only) Professional Internship course credits require the student to be enrolled following the same time frame as all other courses.
- 4. Professional Internship course credit will be graded upon satisfactory completion of the project requirements as defined in the Professional Internship Agreement.

Restrictions

University rules do not normally allow Internship course credits to be counted as Independent Study credits, work-study or hourly pay work done in departments.

How to Enroll

The CLASIC Professional Internship/Research Project Agreement may not be completed retroactively. That is, the agreement is to be completed, signed, and approved by all parties prior to the initiation of the project, and no later than one week prior to the end of the registration period.
