Community Senators:

- Serve as the voting representatives from each residential community
- Meet on a biweekly basis for RHA Senate to discuss legislation, proposals, resolutions, or issues on campus
- Participate in ongoing training and leadership development sessions
- Engage with campus partners, offices, and other organizations to help build community and improve the residential experience
- Meet regularly with their Community's Hall Director, individually or in a group setting depending upon the community
- Elect the RHA Board of Directors
- Submit one Of The Month Award nomination each month
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must not be on university conduct or academic probation
- Must comply with all University and Residence Life policies and procedures
