Leadership Studies Minor

By participating in the INVST Community Leadership Program (CLP), you become eligible to earn **either** the Leadership Studies Minor **or** the Certificate in the Study and Practice of Leadership. You cannot earn both.

The Leadership Studies Minor (LSM) can be earned by:

1) Declaring the Minor by completing a Student Declaration Form that can be obtained from: http://www.colorado.edu/lsm/coursework/declare-minor

The Leadership Studies Minor Requirements are:

- LEAD 1000
- Foundations
- Application
- Context
- LEAD 4000
- Leadership E-Portfolio

For students in the INVST Community Leadership Program, your CLP requirements count towards most of the above in the following ways:

- INVS 3931 replaces LEAD 1000
- INVS 4402 replaces "Foundations"
- INVS 3302 and INVS 3932 replace "Application"
- INVS 4931 and INVS 4932 replace "Context"

You must take each of the above (INVS 3931, 3932, 3302, 4402, 4931 & 4932) for no fewer than 3 credits, in order for them to apply to the Minor.

You must go outside of INVST and take an additional course, LEAD 4000, for 4 credits. It is offered in both the Fall and Spring, and sometimes in the Summer as well. You may not declare or complete your Minor <u>after</u> you graduate from CU. It cannot be added to your transcript at a later time.

When should you declare the LSM?

As soon as possible after you decide you want to earn it. Recommendation: Each member of an entering INVST cohort ought to declare the LSM by March 1 of the year following their Climate Justice Summer.

What happens if it's almost time to graduate from CU but I still haven't taken LEAD 4000?

If you and your Academic Advisor can see that you are not in a position to earn the Minor then you need to un-declare.
