2) <u>Funding Toolkit</u>: the goal of this deliverable was to expedite the grant writing process for the Chef Ann Foundation's development team by creating centralized resource documents making the case for scratch cooking






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## Methods: Recruitment & Enrollment Strategy

- GIS Map: identifies top counties for pilot implementation to maximize recruitment & funding opportunities
   Community-Based Organization Database: enables rapid identification of partner orgaizations for marketing networks
   Focus Group-Tested Messaging:
  - communicates HSFP values and emphasizes most attractive & valueable program elements
