TONAL ANALYSIS

MUSC 5061 Advanced Tonal Analysis (3 cr.) Fall 2021 & Spring 2022 (R5 on prelim exam means that MUSC 5061 is required. NOTE: Students must have passed Aural and Written Theory exams before enrolling in MUSC 5061 or 5000-level theory electives.)

NOTE: All courses used for remediation must be taken for a grade (not Pass/Fail). Master's degree students must pass with a grade of (C) or higher, and DMA/PhD students must pass with a grade of (B-) or higher in order for the course to be accepted for remediation.

Courses taken at levels lower than 5000 (4xxx and below) *cannot* be used to fulfill graduate degree requirements but can be used to remediate preliminary deficiencies as shown above.
