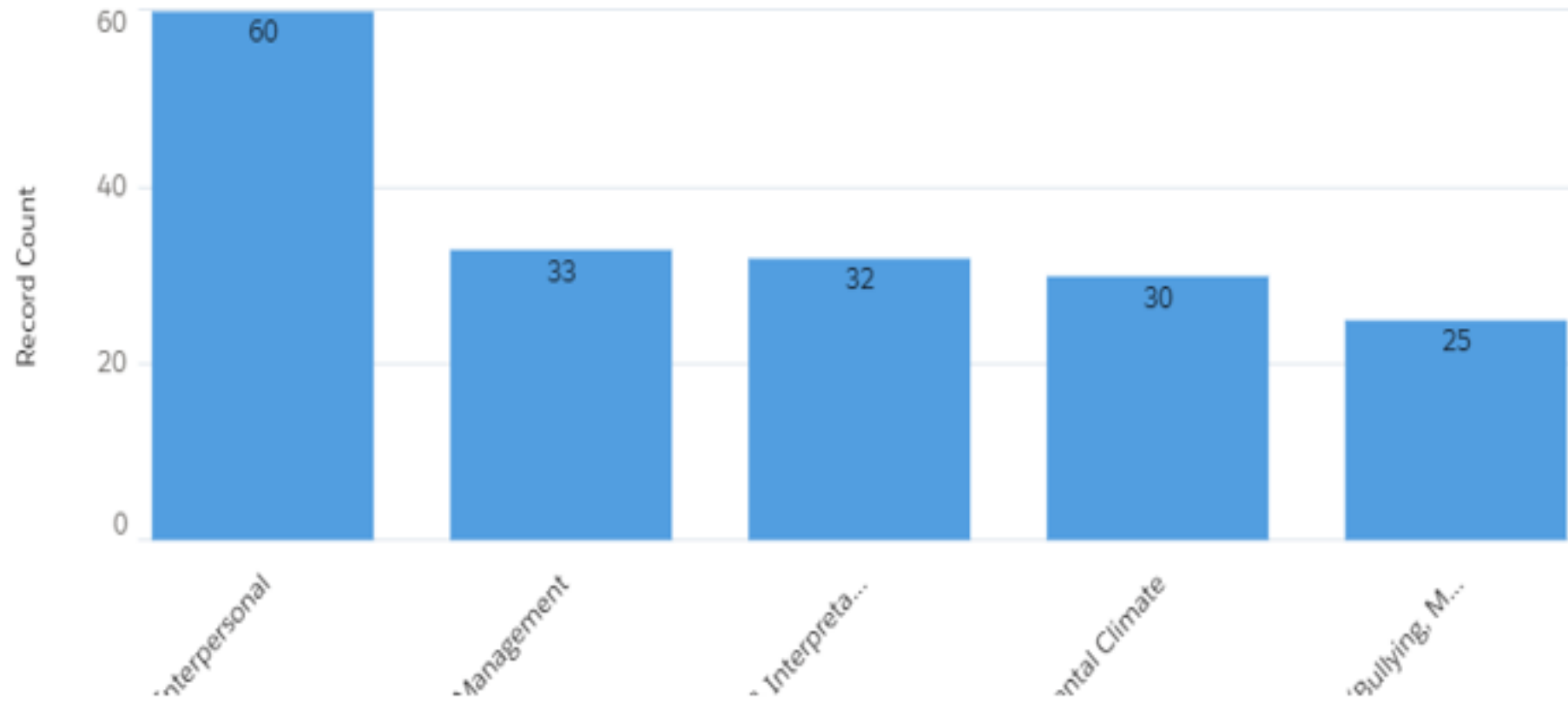

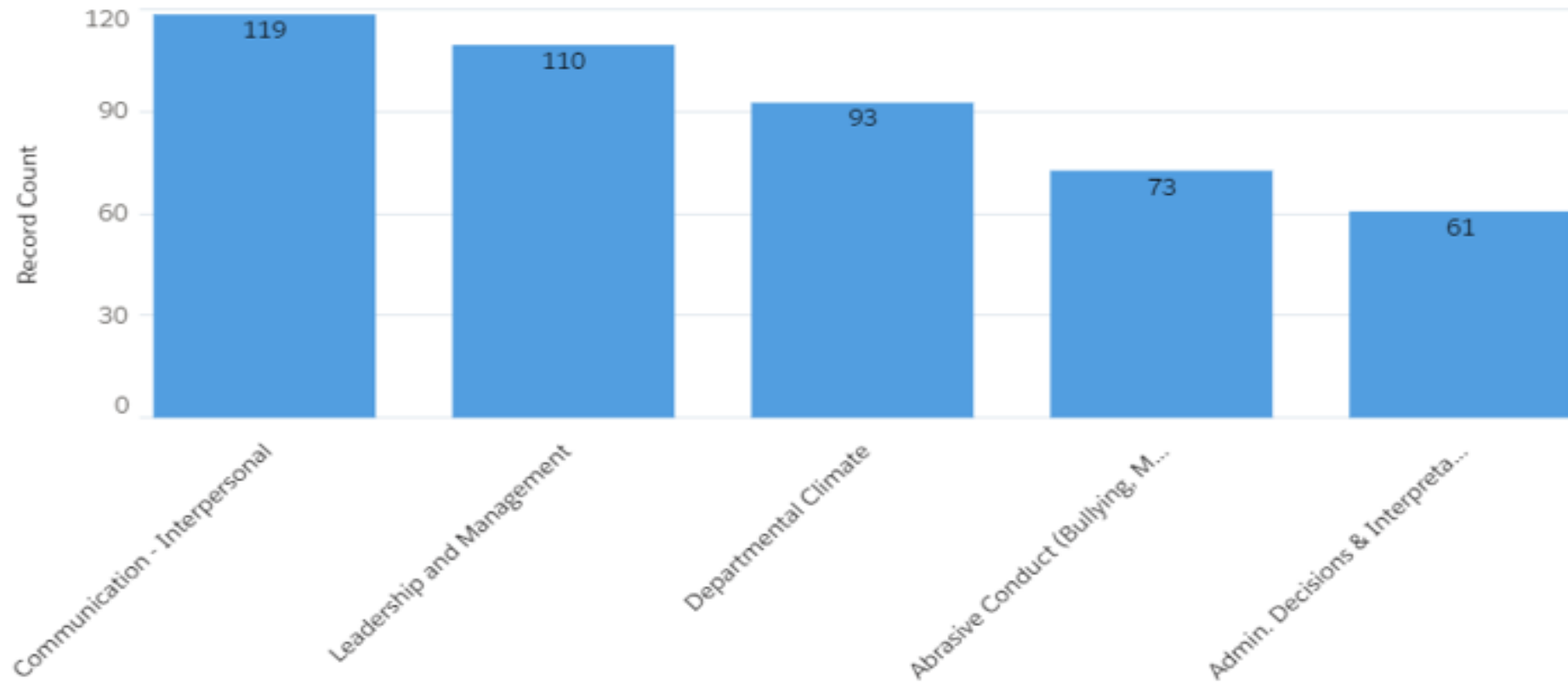
Top 5 concerns of 180 faculty concerns

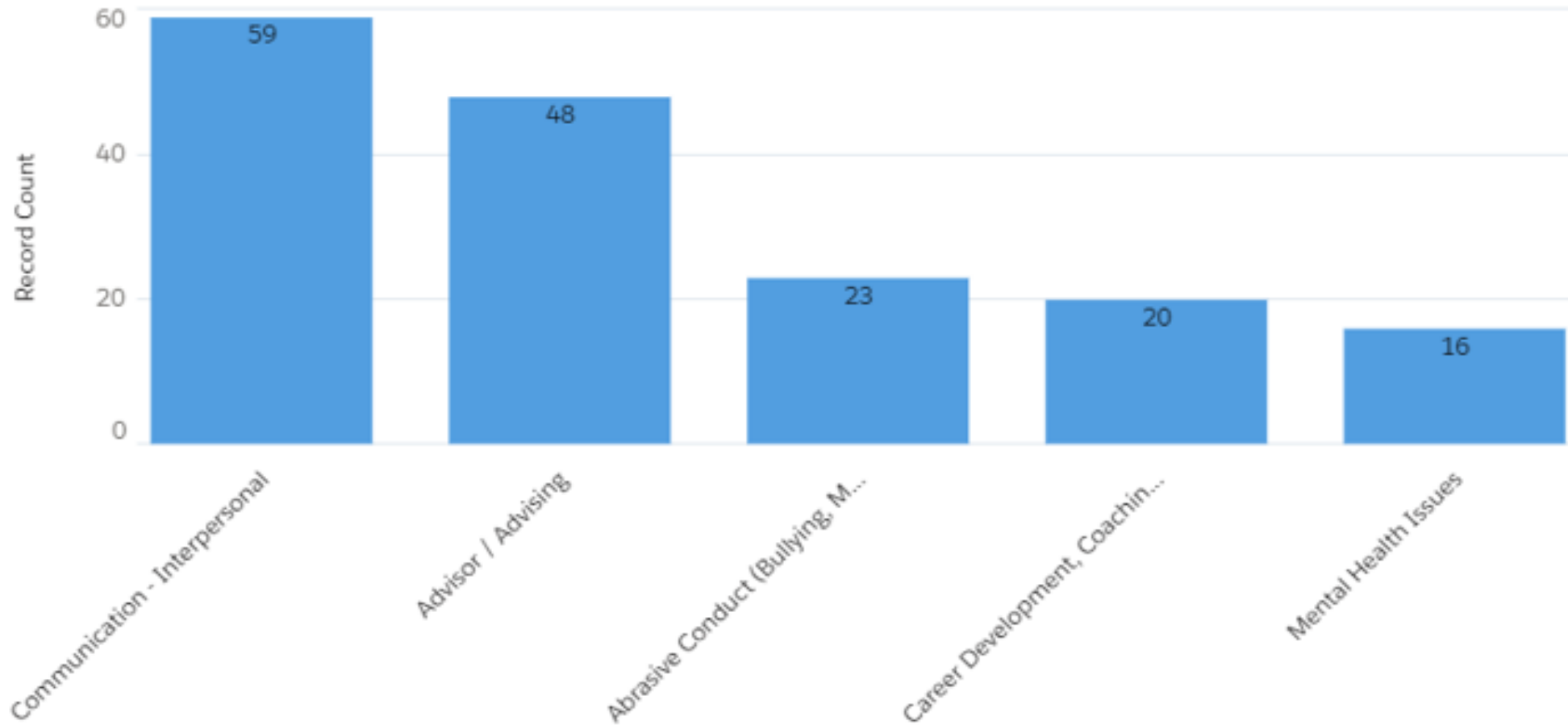

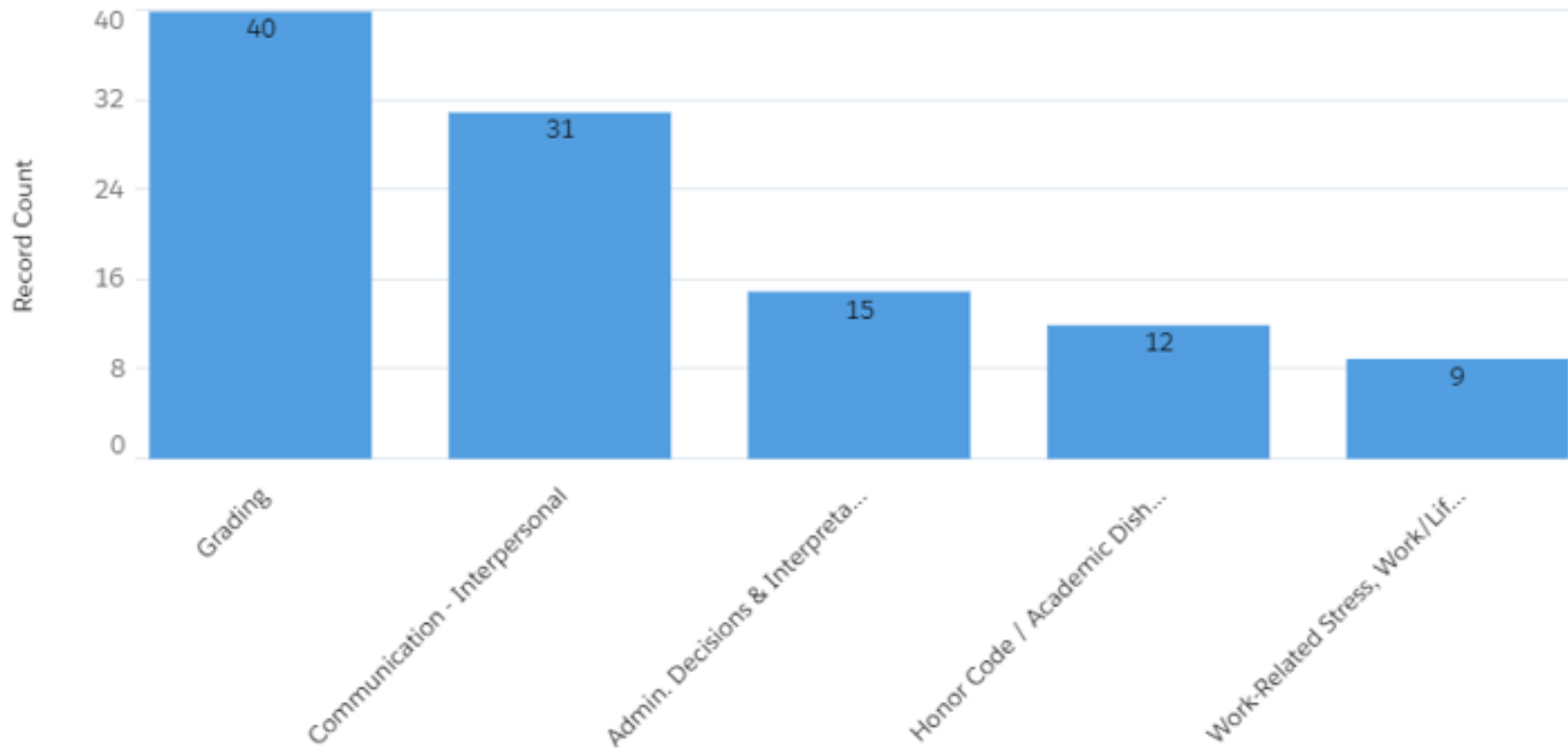
