Note: All courses used for remediation must be taken for a grade (not Pass/Fail). Master's degree students must pass with a grade of C or higher, and DMA/PhD students must pass with a grade of B- or higher in order for the course to be accepted as remediation.

Courses taken at levels lower than 5000 (4xxx or below) can be used to remediate preliminary deficiencies, but **they cannot be used to fulfill graduate degree requirements.**
