Deadline: October 15, 2017

Award Announcement: November 1, 2017 (announced by email)

Eligibility: All high school students currently residing in Colorado.

Judging: The Composition Faculty at the University of Colorado College of Music will act as sole and final judges. The judges are not able to give feedback about entries.

Content Guidelines: This competition primarily seeks to recognize pieces that fit into the tradition of Art Music Composition where all parts are clearly notated or completely composed by the composer. However, original music in any style will be considered. The judges reserve the right to not award any prize. Each person may only submit one piece for consideration. There is no entry fee.

Submission: Fill out the entry form [here](#) and submit a score and recording (live or midi) of your best piece at the end of the entry form. Applications must be received electronically by the deadline of October 15, 2017. Scores should be submitted in PDF format and recordings should be submitted in mp3 format. Each file must be smaller than 15mb in size.
