2018 University of Colorado High School Honor Band

The University of Colorado High School Honor Band is an opportunity for talented young musicians from across the state to join together in the performance of quality concert band literature. Both the rehearsals and performance will take place at the University of Colorado. Check-in will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, February 23 with masterclasses, rehearsals, and the CU Wind Symphony and Symphonic Band Concert that evening. The honor band will rehearse from approximately 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 24, 2018 and perform a concert in Macky Auditorium that evening. Exact times will be provided upon acceptance.

Auditions are open to **all** students grades 9-12. Students have a choice when completing their audition: They can either submit an audio recording via our online registration, OR they can complete a live audition at one of our regional audition sites. ALL STUDENTS must complete the steps below to be considered for CU High School Honor Band. We are unable to accept auditions by email attachment or physical mail.

Please note that we are using the Colorado All-State music as audition music, and chair placement within the ensemble will be based on the initial audition.

ALL audition submissions must be submitted no later than 3:00pm on December 6, 2017. Directors will receive a list of students selected for CU Honor Band and all students will be notified by December 15, 2017. Music for the festival will be emailed to the selected students by the first week in February. If selected for the Honor Band, students will be expected to attend **all** scheduled rehearsals and activities on February 23 - February 24, 2017, including attending the Friday evening Wind Symphony-Symphonic Band Concert. Parents are responsible for transportation, lodging, and supervision at all other times during the Honor Band weekend.

Fees:

There is **no fee to audition**; the cost to participate in the festival if selected is \$20.00 per student.

On the following page, you will find a step-by-step process for submitting your audition.

High School Honor Band Audition Process

STEP 1: Prepare to record or perform your audition

- 1. Prepare the requirements for your instrument. Practice stating your name, grade, school and instrument, and performing the scales and etudes in the order you will record/perform them.
- 2. No metronome is allowed for auditions.
- 3. If you are submitting your audition recording, gather the materials you need to record your audition. For best results, make recordings using a high-quality microphone.

If submitting your audio file for your audition:

STEP 2: Record your audition

- 1. Record **one** student per file.
- 2. Do not alter the audition recording in any way.
- Confirm that your file has finalized and is playable. Unplayable audition submissions will not be eligible for scoring.
- 4. Save your file name as "LAST NAME_FIRST NAME.mp3" (ex. mckinney_donald.mp3).

STEP 3: Submit the online registration form

 All students must submit the online registration form, regardless of audition method (audio file upload or live audition). <u>Note</u>: The first section is director information; student information is submitted in section 2 of the form.

- 3. If students are auditioning on more than one instrument, please submit the form for each separate instrument audition.
- Online recorded audition submissions must be UPLOADED NO LATER THAN December 6, 2017 at 3:00pm.

If auditioning at one of our regional live audition sites:

STEP 2: Submit the online registration form

 All students must submit the online registration form, regardless of audition method (audio file upload or live audition). <u>Note</u>: The first section is director information; student information is submitted in section 2 of the form.

- 2. If auditioning at CU, students will have the opportunity to *request* their live audition time via this form. CU Honor Band staff will confirm an audition time within 5 business days.
- 3. If students are auditioning on more than one instrument, please submit the form for each separate instrument audition.
- 4. Online registrations MUST be completed 48 hours before your live audition.

STEP 3: Schedule your live audition

 If auditioning Cheyenne Mountain, Cherry Creek, or Loveland High Schools, contact the band director at your regional live audition site to schedule your audition time.

STEP 4: Perform your live audition

1. Arrive early to your audition site. Give yourself plenty of time to find the correct room(s), warm up, and not feel rushed.
