## Purpose of this form

The Code of Ethics of the National Association of Schools of Music (NASM) states that "a transferring student who has not completed a degree program can be considered eligible for financial aid during the first term of enrollment in the new institution only if the music executive of the school from which the students is transferring specifically approves. Approval is to be sought prior to the offering of the financial award by the institution to which the student may transfer."
