1.THE PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT IS TO PROVIDE A QUICK, AT A GLANCE REVIEW OF THE EVENT AND ANSWER ANY GENERAL QUESTIONS THAT MAY BE ASKED.

2.LOCATION: BALCH FIELDHOUSE, CU BOULDER.

3.MATERIALS

-EACH COLOR GUARD WILL NEED TO BRING THREE (3) FLAGS; MARINE, NAVY, AND NATIONAL.

-TWO (2) M1 RIFLES

-THREE (3) HARNESES FOR THE FLAG BEARERS

~IF THERE IS A COLOR GUARD THAT CAN NOT BRING, OR FORGET TO BRING, ONE OF THESE ITEMS OF EQUIPMENT, THEN THEY CAN BE RENTED FROM CU NAVAL ROTC'S EQUIPMENT.

4.UNIFORM

-THE UNIFORM FOR THIS EVENT IS STRIPPED KHAKIS. THE ONLY ITEM THAT SHOULD STILL HAVE A PIN IN IT IS THE ANCHOR OR EGA ON YOUR COVER.

-THIS IS A FORMAL EVENT WHERE WE RESPECT THE COLORS THAT GUARD OUR NATION, UNIFORMS SHOULD REFLECT THIS AND LOOK VERY SHARP.

-SHINED SHOES, SHARP CREASES, AND A CLEAN CUT FACIAL APPEARANCE ARE EXPECTED.

5.DRILL DECK

-THE DIMENSIONS OF THE DRILL DECK WILL BE TWENTY BY THIRTY YARDS (20X30).

-THE SURFACE WILL BE A HARDWOOD FLOOR.

-THE BORDER WILL BE MARKED WITH CONES AND/OR TAPE.

6.TIMELINE

-0700: Volunteers, OIC, and AOIC go to Field House and tape off drill deck/prepare for competition.

-0730: Volunteers, OIC, AOIC, and judges will meet in the Wardroom and walk over to Carlson Gym.

-0800: First team promptly arrives. Five (5) Minute warm-up period ends at 0805. Report in to Head Judge. Then ten (10) minutes will be given to complete the drill card. Followed by five (5) minutes to receive scores and be given a debriefing.

-0820: Team Two arrives and begins above procedure.

- 0840: Team Three arrives and begins above procedure.
- 0900: Team Four arrives and begins above procedure.
- 0920: Team Five arrives and begins above procedure.
- 0940: Thirty (30) minute break
- 1010: Team Six arrives and begins above procedure.
- 1030: Team Seven arrives and begins above procedure.
- 1050: Team Eight arrives and begins above procedure.
- 1110: Team Nine arrives and begins above procedure.
- 1130: Team Ten arrives and begins above procedure.

-TEAMS ARE EXPECTED TO BE TWENTY (20) MINUTES EARLY. IF TEAMS ARE NOT ON TIME, A POINT DEDUCTION OR COMPLETE DISQUALIFICATION WILL OCCUR. THE EVENT OIC, AOIC, AND MASTER JUDGE WILL HAVE THE FINAL SAY IN THIS DETERMINATION.
