- 1. The Squad and Platoon portions of the Drill competition are now being held on Kittredge Fields Middle and South, which are indicated in Enclosure (7) Map.
- 2. Platoon Drill will be judged by 4 AMOIs.
- 3. Individual Drill will not be an event at the Colorado Meet this year.
- 4. The calisthenic portion of the Endurance Race will now be held on Farrand Field, which is indicated in Enclosure (7) Map.
- 5. During each Knowledge round there will be one land navigation and one maneuvering board question. When the question is asked, teams will have three minutes to complete them. Points will be awarded to the team that can correctly complete the question fastest. If incorrect, the other team has an opportunity to answer within three minutes. When teams have an answer they will buzz in.
- 6. Teams are allowed to watch the competition only once they have completed the round that they are watching. They are not permitted to watch if they have not yet been asked the questions in the round they are watching.
- 7. Knowledge Competition Loser's Bracket will be held in the small courtroom. Losers bracket rounds will contain the same questions as the winner's bracket and will go at the same time. There is no formal structure. It will be a first come first serve for one match at a time.
- 8. The Knowledge competition OIC and AOIC reserve the right to, at their discretion, disqualify teams if foul play is suspected.

- 9. After the completion of each round, the teams that will be advancing will be announced; in addition, a spreadsheet will be updated with the teams that advance. Team captains will have the link to this spreadsheet, and it will be updated within ten minutes of the completion of rounds one, two, and three. Teams that advance will check in before the start of the next round.
- 10. MECEPs and Navy Officer Candidates may not compete in the shooting competition.
- 11. The range safety officer (RSO) is responsible for range observation and safety. They have the right to remove competitors if they are deemed unsafe to handle the weapons. The RSO will check Midshipmen's knowledge of Weapons Conditions and test the Midshipmen on the four Weapons Safety Rules. Failure to know to know the Weapons Safety Rules WILL result in that school's team being disqualified from the Shooting Competition.
- 12. Shooting Competition Pistol Course of Fire. The first stage single target engagement stage will now have 12 rounds.
- 13. Shooting Competition Rifle Course of Fire will be modified as such: Rifle course of fire: Standard NRA rules will be applied in the conduct of this competition: A double course will be fired. Five rounds will be fired in the following positions: prone, kneeling and standing. While shooting from the prone position, no part of the weapon at any time shall touch the ground. Slings are authorized for the kneeling and prone positions only. Slings are not authorized in the standing position. Shooters will receive forty (40) rounds of ammunition in total. Five minutes of preparatory time will be allotted before the course of fire to set up equipment on the firing line, get into position and fire to up to ten (10) sighting rounds. The sighting rounds must remain inside the sighting ring (which encircles the center two targets). If there are any rounds outside of the sighting ring, the target closest to the stray round will be counted as zero. Teams will then have fifteen (15) minutes to fire all scoring rounds for the first stage of the rifle course of fire from the twenty-five (25) yard firing line. One round will be fired at five (5) perimeter targets to be scored. If two rounds are fired on the same target, the highest scoring round will be counted.

### 14. Pistol Course of Fire

- a. Stage 2: Each shooter stands in between two lanes. Their targets will be in the lane to the immediate left and immediate right.
- (1). 7 yard line: single headshot on one (1) target (timer will state left then right target prior to command "targets"). Shooting the wrong target will result in a loss of 5 points. (x2)

- (2) 7 yard line: 2 shots to the torso on each target, followed by single headshot to each target. Time limit 6 seconds. (x2)
- (3) 10 yard line: 2 shots standing on each target. Time limit 6 seconds.
- (4) 15 yard line: 2 shots standing on left target, 2 shots kneeling on right target. Time limit 8 seconds.
- b. On the command "Standby", shooters may take aim and take off the safety of the weapon.

### Endurance Race Workout

1. The pool portion of the race has been moved from the CU Rec Center Clare Small Pool to the CU Rec Center Dive Well. The location of the calisthenics portion has changed from Kittredge Field South to Farrand Field.

### POOL (1)

Part 1 of the pool portion will consist of treading water, swimming, and pull-ups. Squads will tread water in MARPATs/NWUs while one team member at a time swims to the other end. Once there, that individual will exit the pool and conduct pull-ups. As a team, 40 pull-ups must be completed. Every team member must swim down at least once. Every team member must conduct at least 1 pull-up. Once complete, that individual will swim back to their respective squad and resume treading. When they return, another team member will swim down and repeat the exercise, until 40 total pull-ups have been completed. One brick must be held above the water by the treading squad at all times. All team members must swim. Once the last team member returns, squads may stop treading and immediately begin Pool (2). The brick may be placed on the pool deck for the rest of the pool portion.

If the brick is dropped, the squad member swimming and conducting pull-ups must stop until the brick is retrieved by pool staff and brought above water again. In addition, a 1 minute penalty will be incurred. Touching a wall also results in a 1 minute penalty. All penalties will be added onto the squad's time after completion of the station. Every member of the squad must tread, and every member must hold the brick. Gear will be staged on the pool deck. Boots will not be worn for Pool (1) or Pool (2). In the case of a squad member not being able to complete the event entirely, the remaining members of the squad will finish without them and a 5 minute time penalty will be enforced.

## Pool(2)

Part 2 of the pool portion will consist of swimming and calisthenics. Squads will start in one end of the pool in NWUs/MARPATs immediately following Pool (1). Each squad will travel as one group throughout the duration of the evolution. All exercises explained will be done simultaneously by each individual of the team, not as total repetitions by the team. Starting on one side of the pool, squads will conduct 10 squad sit ups with arms interlocked. From there, the squad will swim the length of the pool to the other end and perform 25 gutter

ups. When the squad swims back, they will conduct 15 sit ups. Each time, sit ups will increase by 5 and gutter ups will decrease by 5, until 25 sit ups and 10 gutter ups have been completed.

A complete gutter up is placing hands on the pool deck and lifting the body up until arms are locked out.

A complete squad sit up is every member of the squad touching elbows to thighs simultaneously while keeping arms interlocked with one another.


Incorrect exercises will not count. Safety Observers will judge form for all exercises. Each member of the squad will participate. Gear will be staged on the pool deck. Boots will not be worn during Pool (2). A 55 minute time limit will be enforced for the entire pool evolution. In the case of a squad member not being able to complete the event, the remaining squad members will finish and a 5 minute time penalty will be incurred.


The squads will then exit the pool and change into dry MARPATs/NWUs. Wet MARPATs/NWUs will be placed in a garbage bag, then into a pack combined with the squad's water sources and required weight. Distribute as the squad sees fit.

### Calisthenics Station (Tires)

All squad members must be fully bloused for this evolution. This land-based PT station consists of various calisthenic movements. Squad will first bear crawl the length of the soccer field. They will then partner up and conduct wheelbarrows back to the line at midfield. There, they will switch roles with their partner and wheelbarrow the rest of the way back. Squads will then conduct burpee broad jumps to midfield and low crawl to the other end. To get back, teams will repeat the same sequence. Once the entire squad has returned, they will partner up and buddy drag to midfield. There, they will switch roles with their partner and buddy drag back. The next phase will consist of overhead plate presses and pushups. Squads will split into two groups of three. One group will run with 3 total 35lb plates down to the other end of the field, conduct 30 overhead presses with a plate, and run back. Simultaneously, the second group will conduct 150 total pushups between the three team members. Every member must complete at least 25. Simultaneously, the second group will conduct 150 total pushups between the three team members. Every member must complete at least 25. When both

groups are finished, they will switch and conduct the other exercise. The final phase will be tire flips. Two squad members will flip a tire to midfield and back, while the remaining four members hold a front leaning rest. Squads will switch tire flippers until every member has participated.


