To join the College Program (Basic Standing) you will need to complete the following application. The College Program allows you to fully participate in the unit and attempt to earn a scholarship during your time with the unit. You can earn either a 3-year or a 2-year scholarship. You will have the opportunity to earn the scholarship based on your GPA, physical fitness scores, and military aptitude. You will have this opportunity until you have two years remaining to finish your degree. If you have not earned a scholarship by this time, or you have not earned College Program (Advanced Standing) status, you will be involuntarily disenrolled from the program.

The College Program application consists of the following:

- College Program Minimum Eligibility Requirements
- Un-official copy of High School and/or CollegiateTranscript
- Un-official copy of either ACT or SAT Scores
- Report of Medical History (DD2807-1) *Can be completed by family doctor
- Personal Statement (Why you want to join CU NROTC)
