Subj: SHOOTING EVENT SUMMARY

WHO: SHOOTING TEAMS OF INVITED NROTC UNITS ACROSS THE COUNTRY WILL BE COMPETING IN THE SHOOTING PORTION OF THE COLORADO MEET. EACH SCHOOL WILL CONSIST 4 PISTOL SHOOTERS, AND 4 RIFLE SHOOTERS. SHOOTERS ARE AUTHORIZED TO HAVE MEMBERS ON BOTH RIFLE AND PISTOL TEAMS, ALTHOUGH IT IS NOT MANDATORY. EACH SCHOOL WILL HAVE ONE PISTOL CAPTAIN, ONE RIFLE CAPTAIN, AND AS MUCH STAFF COACHING FOR PREPARATION. DURING THE EVENT, CAPTAINS AND STAFF ARE NOT AUTHORIZED IN THE FIRING RANGE.

WHAT: THE PISTOL THAT WILL BE USED DURING THE COMPETITION WILL BE 22 CAL. PISTOLS. THE AMMUNITION THAT WILL BE USE IS THE WINCHESTER T22 LONG RIFLE TARGET STANDARD VELOCITY RIMFIRE CARTRIDGES. TEAMS ARE AUTHORIZED TO USE SHOOTING JACKETS, SLINGS, STANDS, SHOOTING MATS, ETC. RIFLE SHOOTERS WILL COMPETE IN A COURSE OF FIRE THAT INCLUDES 10 SHOTS IN PRONE, KNEELING AND STANDING POSITIONS. THE TARGET FOR RIFLE SHOOTERS WILL BE THE 50FOOT NRA SMALLBORE TARGET. RIFLE SHOOTERS ARE AUTHORIZED TO WEAR SHOOTING JACKETS AND SLINGS IN THE COMPETITION. THE TARGET THAT WILL BE USED DURING THE PISTOL PORTION OF THE COMPETITION IS THE STANDARD USPSA TARGET. THE COURSE OF FIRE WILL CONSIST OF VARIOUS DISTANCES FROM THE TARGET, AND VARIOUS STANCES OVER THE COURSE OF TWO STAGES(SINGLE TARGET ENGAGEMENT AND MULTIPLE TARGET ENGAGEMENT). PISTOL SHOOTERS ARE AUTHORIZED TO SHOOT IN WEAVER POSITION OR STANDARD POSITION. UNITS MAY BRING THEIR OWN FIREARMS AND STORE THEM AT CU. IF THE NEED ARISES THE CU BATTALION CAN RENT RIFLES TO TEAMS. ALSO, AMMUNITION WILL BE PROVIDED BY EACH COMPETING TEAM, IF NECESSARY AMMUNITION CAN BE BOUGHT FROM THE CU BATTALION. ALL COMPETITORS AND AUTHORIZED SPECTATORS **WILL** WEAR EAR AND EYE PROTECTION.


WHEN: TEAMS WILL COMPETE ON THE DAYS OF 1ST MARCH(CU BATTALION ONLY), 2ND MARCH, AND 3RD MARCH 2018. THE COMPETITION WILL TAKE PLACE ALL THROUGHOUT EACH DAY OF THE COLORADO MEET. PISTOL TEAMS WILL COMPETE FIRST, IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWED BY THE RIFLE TEAM OF THE SAME SCHOOL.

WHERE: THE SHOOTING COMPETITION WILL BE IN AN INDOOR RANGE. THE COMPETITION WILL BE AT AN INDOOR RANGE OFF-CAMPUS. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THIS IS THE ONLY EVENT THAT IS NOT CENTRALIZED AT THE COLORADO BATTALION'S HEADQUARTERS. EXACT LOCATION OF THE EVENT WILL BE PUBLISHED WITH THE LOI. IN THE CASE OF AN INJURY, UNITS ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE THE INJURED PERSONNEL TO THE NEAREST HOSPITAL, WHICH IS FOOTHILLS HOSPITAL, LOCATED AT 4747 Arapahoe Ave, Boulder, CO 80303. TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION OF THEIR PERSONNEL AS WELL AS THEIR GEAR TO AND FROM THE COMPETITION. TEAMS ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR STORING THEIR OWN GEAR BEFORE THE COMPETITION.


