How does it work?

1 Venture Coach Registration

Due Feb 14

Each student team must have an adult 'Venture Coach' to support them through the learning process and serve as main point-of-contact.

2 Student Registration

Due Feb 14

Students form into 'Venture Teams' of 1-6 members to start developing their preliminary idea and create an online venture profile.

3 Round 1 Materials Submission

Due Mar 25

Teams refine their ideas and create a 2-page executive summary and 4-minute video pitch. Materials will be reviewed virtually. Finalists notified by April 1.
