This ensures that CU Boulder has proper controls around those serving in these roles and recognizes that all research endeavors take dedicated commitment. Limited exceptions are identified at the bottom of the chart.

PI, Co-PI and Approver Acceptance of Responsibility

If project requirements are not properly fulfilled and/or deliverables are not met by the PI and Co-PIs, that responsibility will rest with the approver.

Note: Eligibility status will be evaluated at proposal and upon receipt of an award. Additional restrictions on PI eligibility may apply according to sponsor policies as well as for projects involving classified or controlled unclassified information.
