The survey is similar to the admitted student survey for first-time first-year students, but includes a special section specific to transfer students. Generally, the survey inquires about a range of topics including their application experience, financial stressors, expectations of belonging and difficulty, and many more. Note, there is a follow-up admissions survey where we check back in with the confirmed, incoming students.
