- 7076 first-year students were invited to take the survey
- 2216 gave complete responses (31% response rate)

- 2022 results similar to findings from previous 12 years








Percent of Participants Answering "Yes"

2022 Effective Bystander Training (n=2,226) *I am more likely to help people*.




Percent of Participants Answering "Yes"


I have more skills to help someone in a difficult situation.






Program Liking: First Years







2022 Effective Bystander Training (n=2,226) *Trying to assist when someone needs help is like me*.




Percent of Participants Answering 6, 7, or 8 Scale: Not like me (1) to Like me (8)

2022 Effective Bystander Training (n=2,226) *Trying to assist when someone needs help is my business*.




Percent of Participants Answering 6, 7, or 8 Scale: Not my business (1) to My business (8)
