# 2024 Assessment Overview

- 3 areas of program evaluation:
  - Efficacy
  - Liking
  - Helping Attitudes
- 6615 first-year students were invited to take the survey
- 3567 gave complete responses (50% response rate)
- Survey period: 8/27-9/10
- 2024 results similar to findings from previous 14 years



- 3218 Not First-generation

***I will be able to notice more situations where people need help.***




**Percent of Participants Answering "Yes"**

***I am more likely to help people.***




# Program Efficacy: First Years

***I have more skills to help someone in a difficult situation.***




# Program Efficacy: First Years

***How much did the training improve your skills?***




# Program Liking: First Years

**2024 Effective Bystander Training (n=3,786)**


***Improved my confidence about being able to intervene when someone needs help.***

***Was relevant to me as a college student.***




# Program Liking: First Years


***Was an effective way to teach bystander skills.***

*Trying to assist when someone needs help is like me.*




**Percent of Participants Answering 6, 7, or 8
