# 2025 Assessment Overview

- 3 areas of program evaluation:
  - Efficacy
  - Liking
  - Helping Attitudes
- 6308 first-year students were invited to take the survey
- 2463 gave complete responses (39% response rate)
- Survey period: 8/26-9/9
- 2025 results similar to findings from previous 15 years

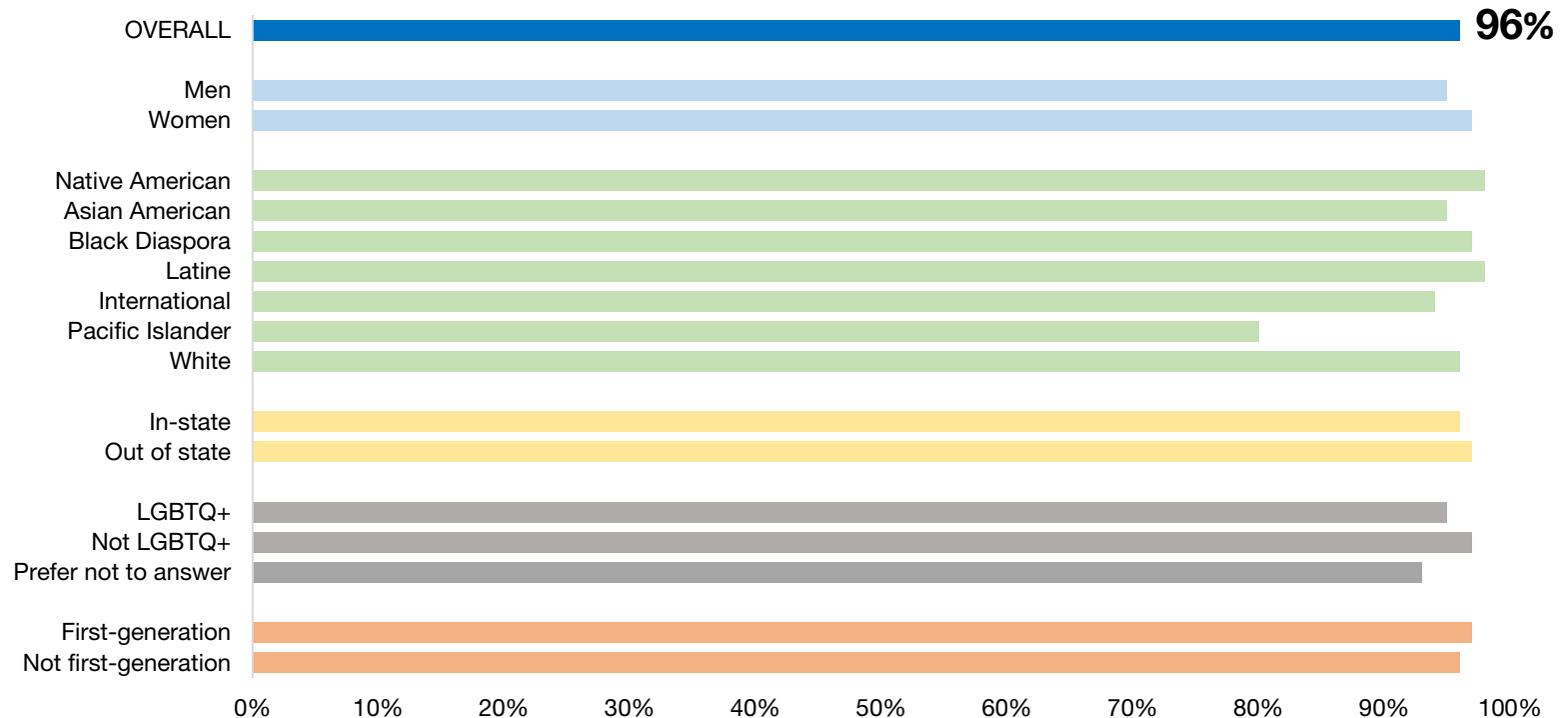

- 1734 Resident
- 399 LGBTQ+
- 2095 Not LGBTQ+
- 148 Prefer not to answer
- 494 First-generation
- 2712 Not First-generation

***I will be able to notice more situations where people need help.***



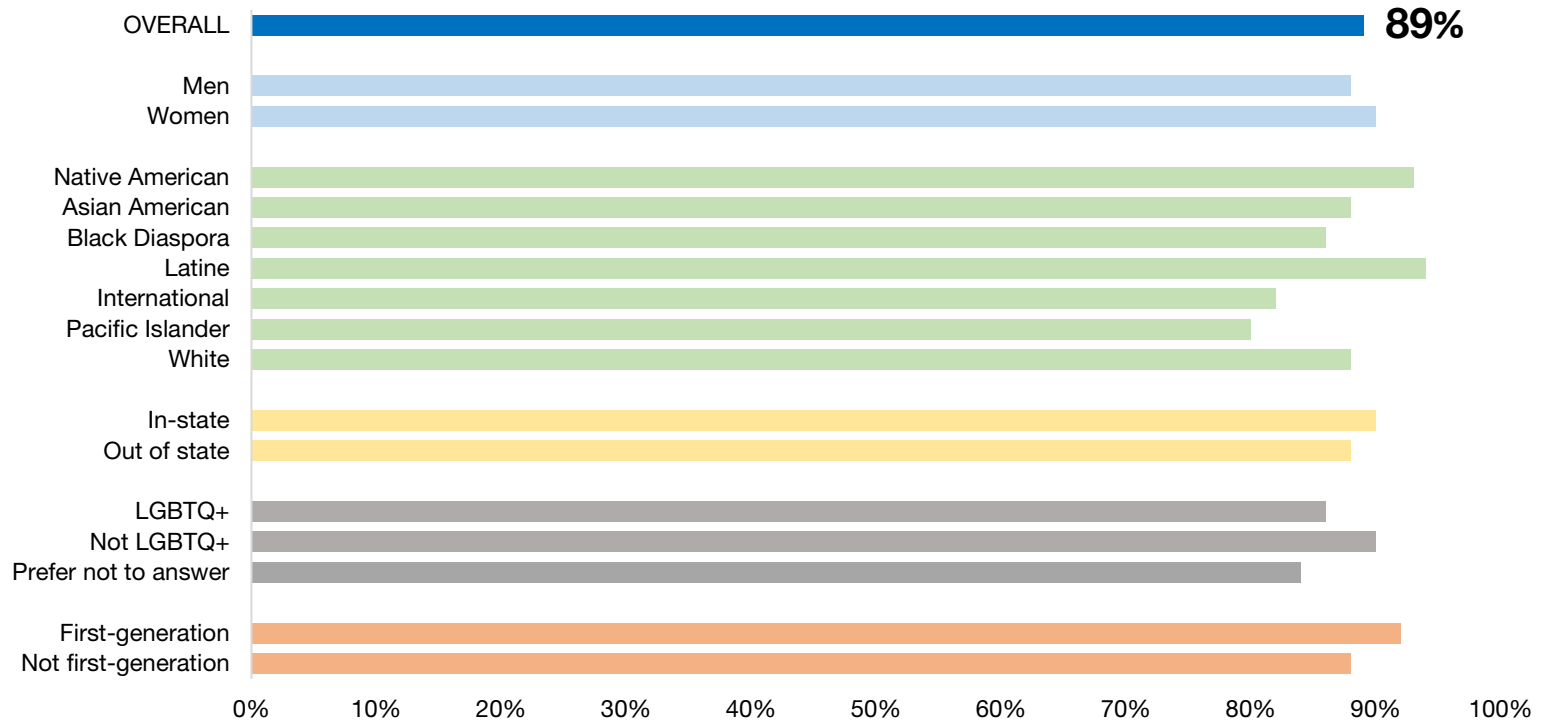
**Percent of Participants Answering "Yes"**

***I am more likely to help people.***



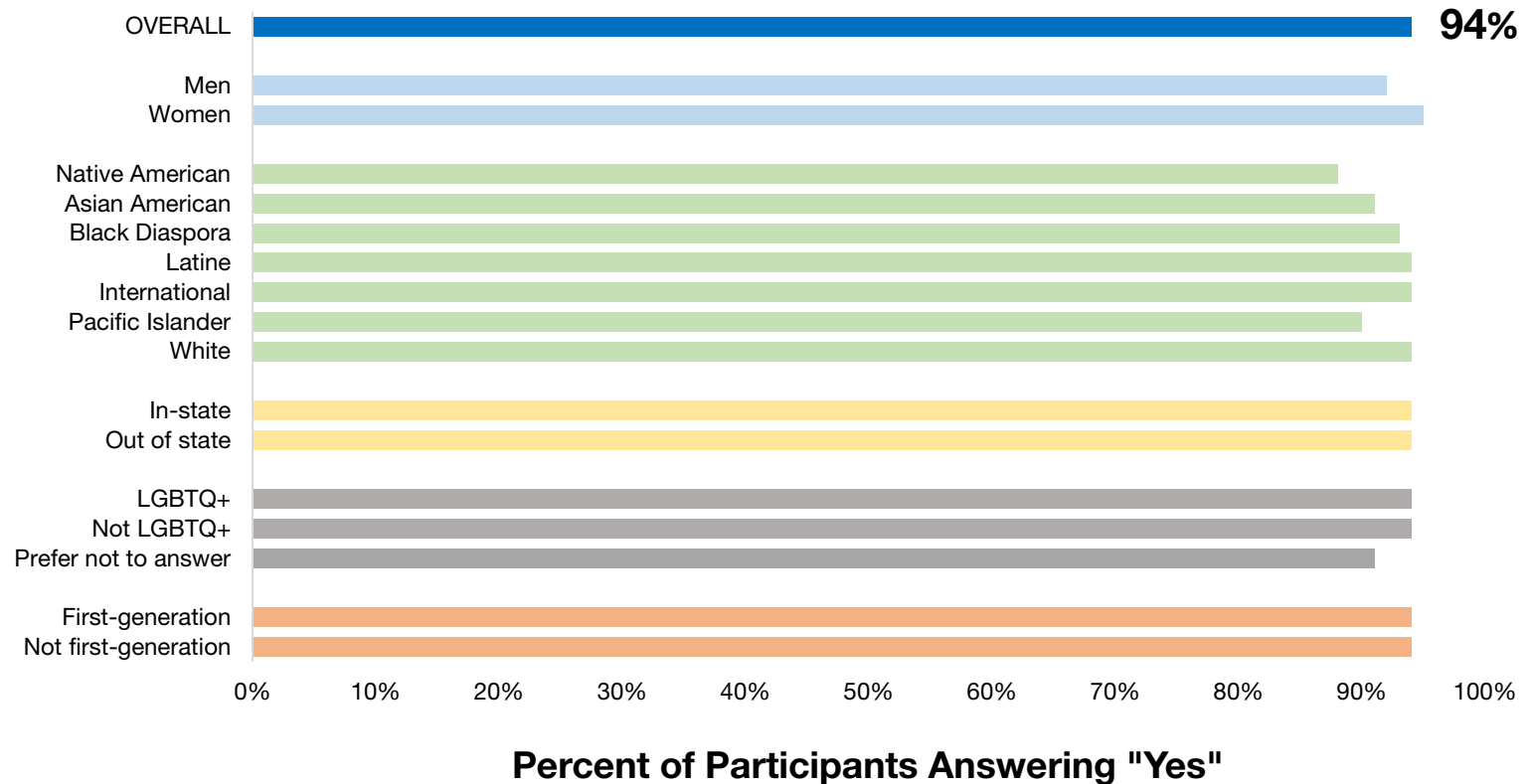
**Percent of Participants Answering "Yes"**

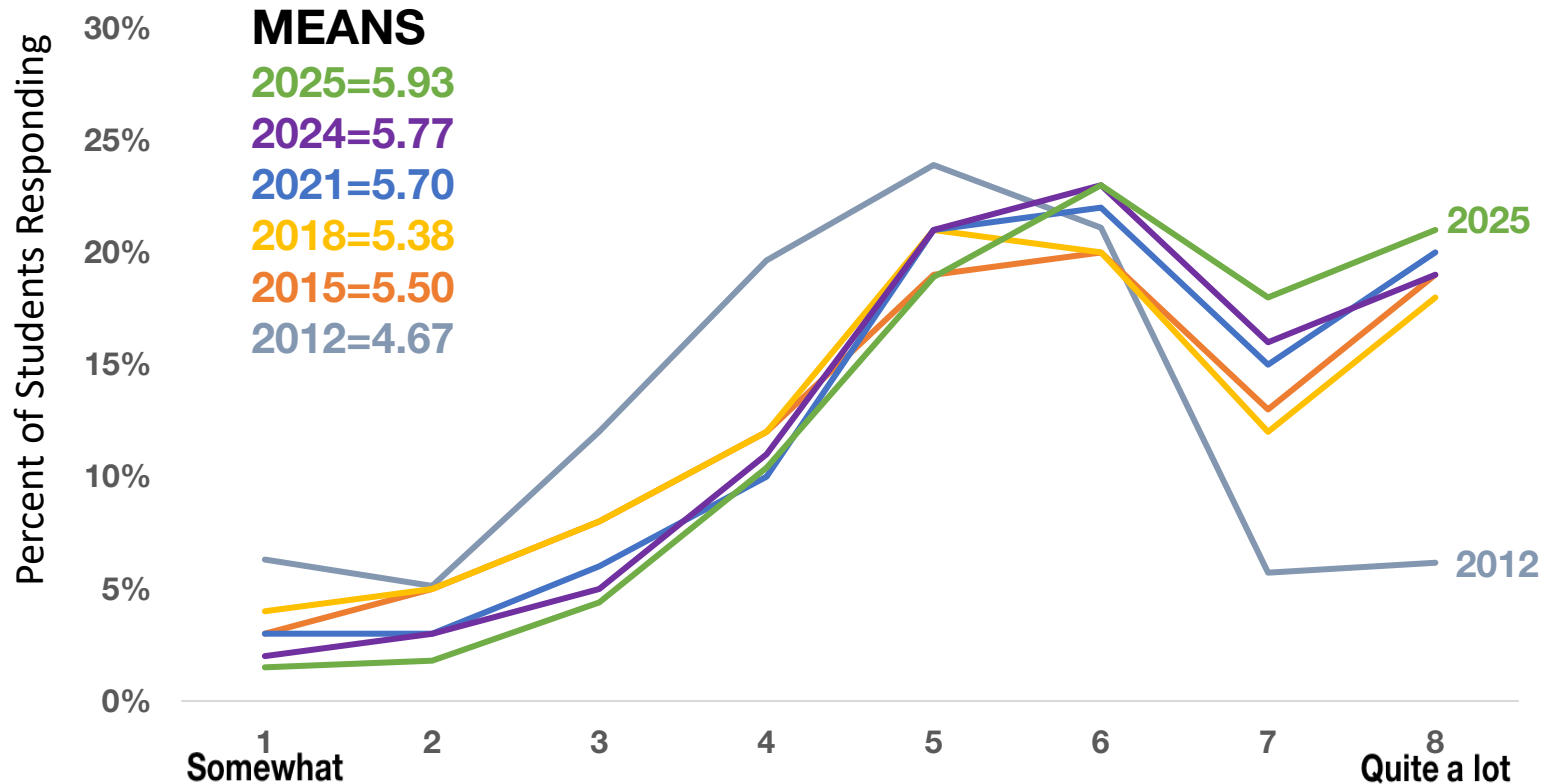
***I have more skills to help someone in a difficult situation.***

***How much did the training improve your skills?***

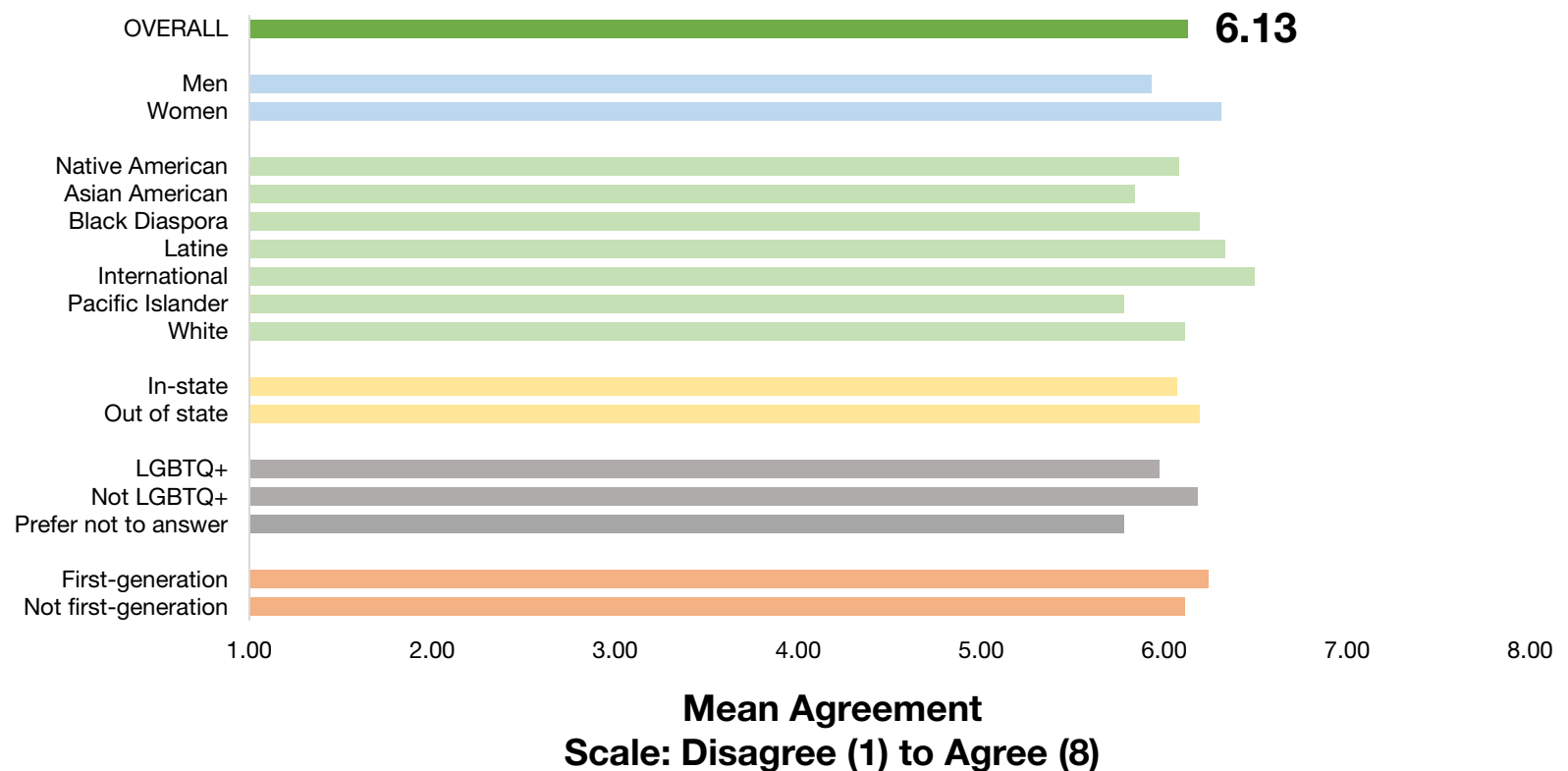


# Program Liking: First Years

***Improved my confidence about being able to intervene when someone needs help.***



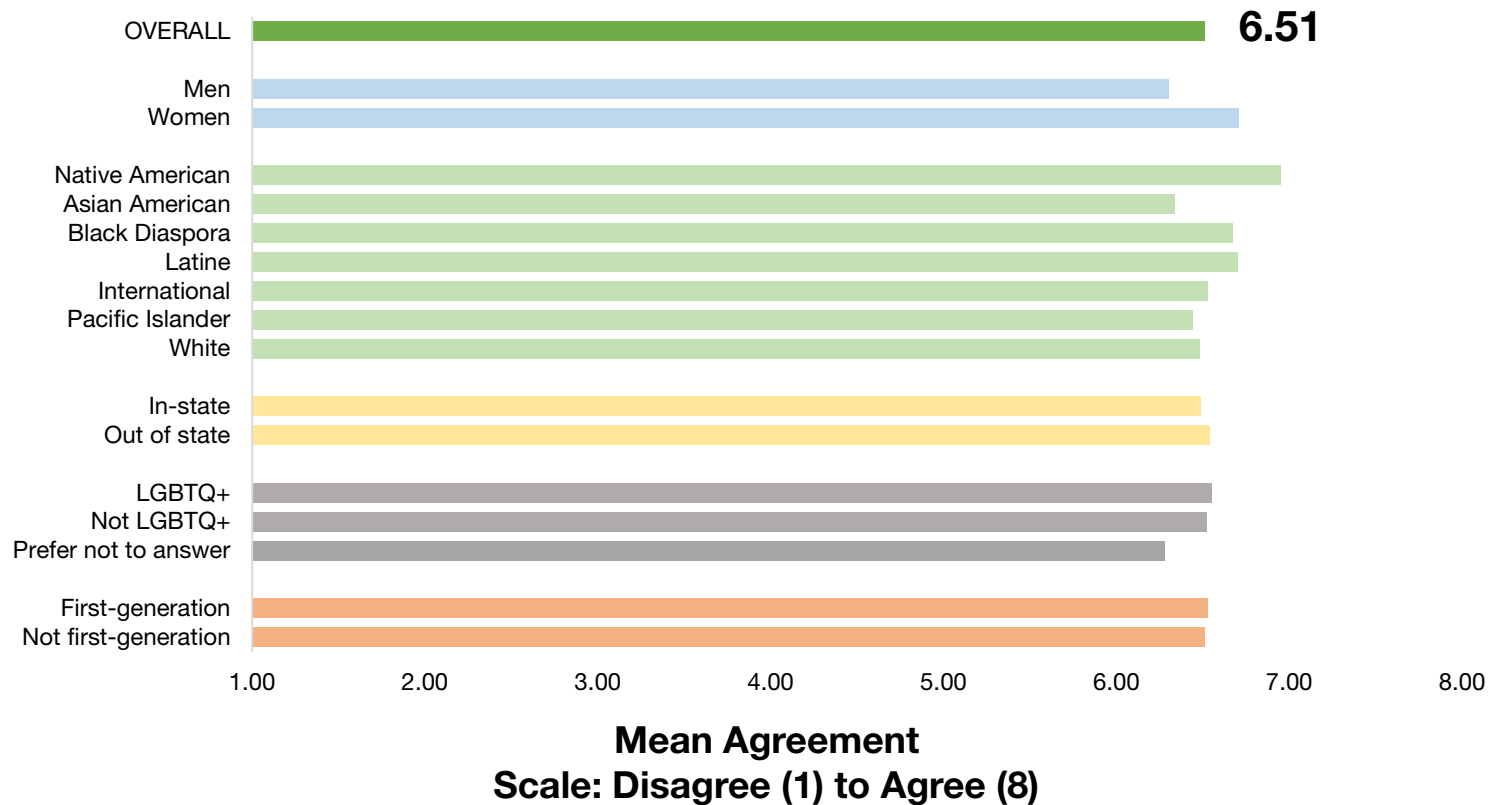


# Program Liking: First Years

***Was relevant to me as a college student.***

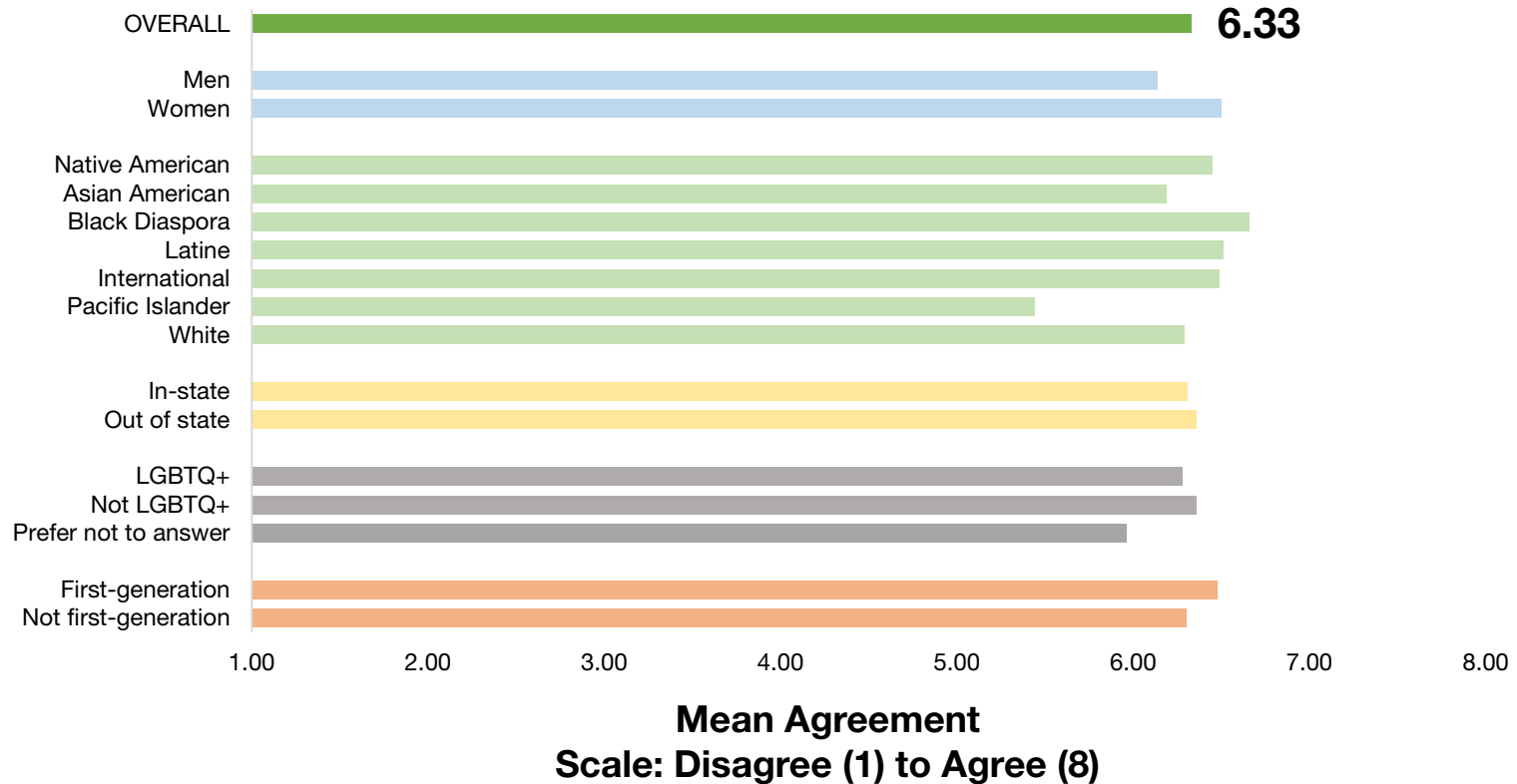

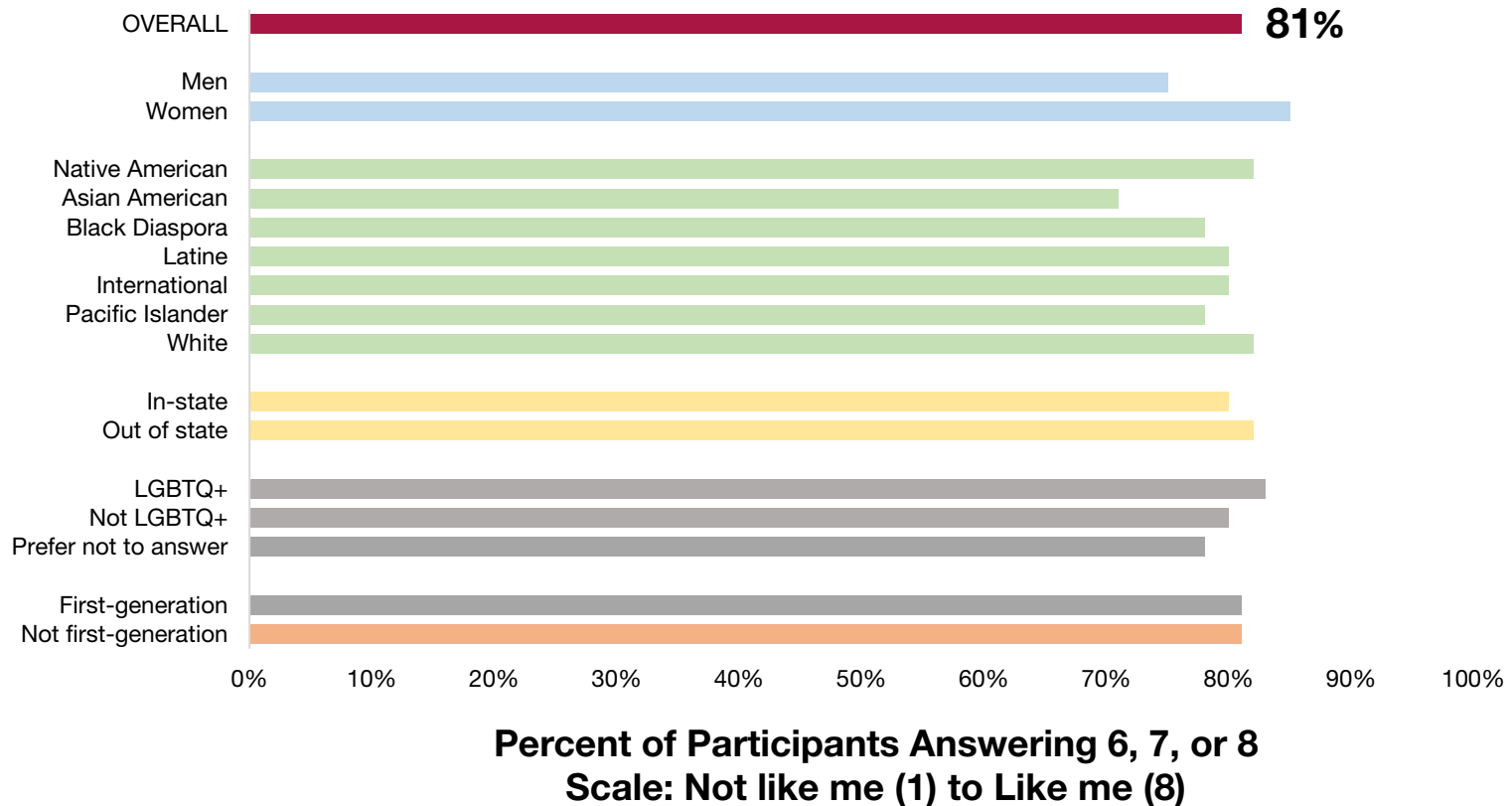
***Was an effective way to teach bystander skills.***

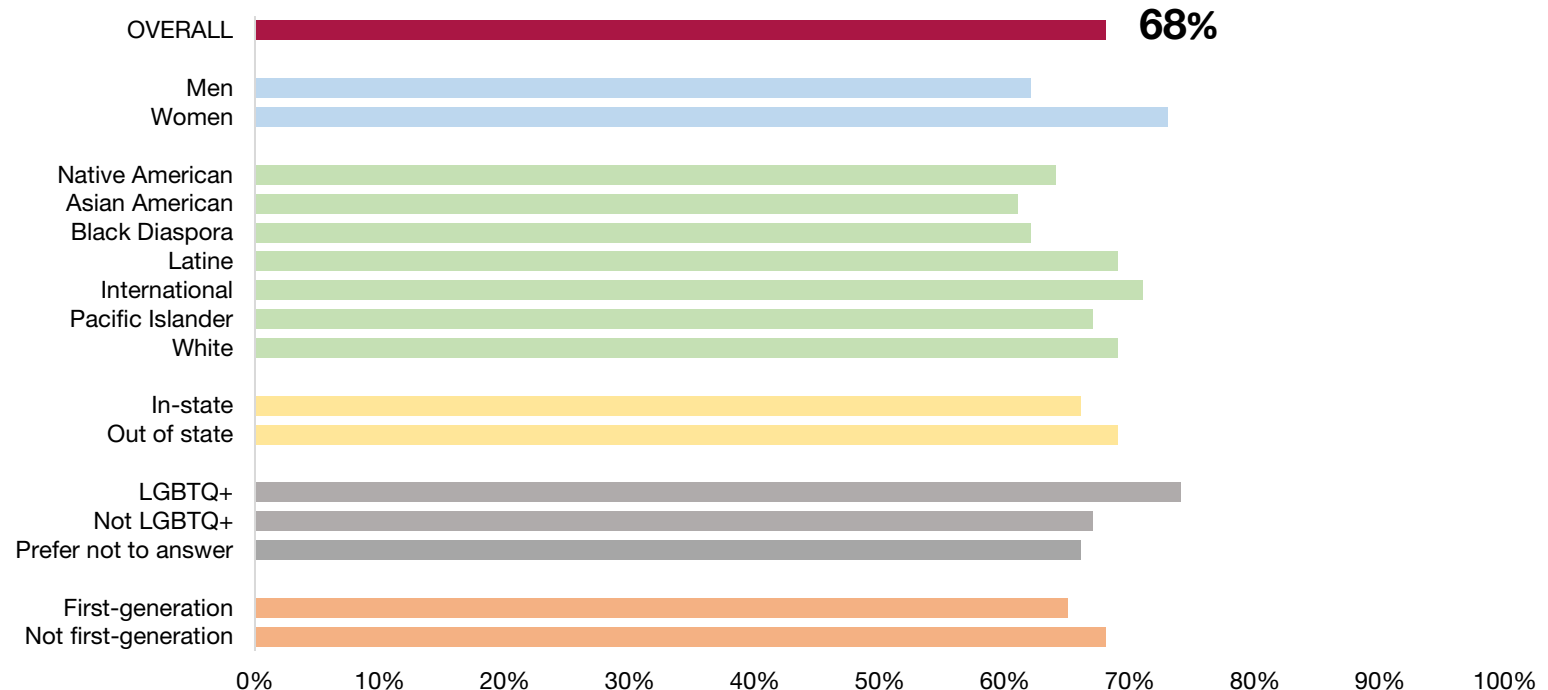
*Trying to assist when someone needs help is like me.*
