



Many students who choose to live outside of Boulder commute daily to campus on the bus.


PARKING OPTIONS

MEAL PLAN OPTIONS

Campus Cash

- Add to your buffone at any time. Doesn't expire. Guest accounts.
- \$11.19/meal with campus cash \$15.01 with a credit/debit card

Block Meal Plan

- Available to all students living off campus.
- 25 50 80 meal options.

Flatiron Meal Plan

- Prepaid dining and discount card.
- Purchase meals and shop for groceries at over 100 Boulder merchants.





LOCAL ORDINANCES

Ordinance NO. 7962

Requires all trash and compost to be secured from bears at all times. Affects all residents living West of Broadway.



No warnings! Fine for 1st offense: \$100



Required to remove snow and ice from sidewalks within 24 hours after snow stops falling.

Could result in fines and costs for a private snow removal contractor.

Stores get "cleaned out"

- Linen & bedding
- Furniture
- Electronics & small appliances
- General household items

SECURITY DEPOSIT

- Complete/turn in check-in sheet on time
- Take photos /video of premises at lease start (before you start moving in)
- Take more photos and video <u>at</u> <u>lease end</u>
 - Document conditions before and after maintenance workers are in unit
- At lease end, do a "deep clean" and follow other move out instructions in the lease



PARTY REGISTRATION

- Warning system for noise complaints
- Helps decrease the likelihood of receiving a ticket while hosting a party

Students complete a FREE one-time 45 minute 'Party Smart' orientation. This allows student to receive warning prior to ticket being written



- IT IS NOT a guarantee you won't get a ticket / citation / police visit
- IT IS NOT CU providing approval or a permit for your event
- IT IS NOT permission to violate local ordinances

HOUSING SEARCH TIMELINE

- Pre-leasing begins in October
 - Rush of leasing -> Eases up early Dec
 - Not recommended
- Main search (signing leases)
 - Jan -> April
- Picks back up June -August
 - Transfers, late admits, housing waitlist, etc.

- 7-Day Demand to Small Claims and beyond
 - Repairs & Warranty of Habitability
