

Roommate Processes

Option 1:

Mutual Roommate Request

- Roommate is priority over living experience
- Will be assigned to one of 13 Traditional halls in a Double w/Community bathroom
- Only available through May 4th
- Students will log in May 5th through May 11th to confirm roommates

Option 2:

Roommate Selection Process

- Living experience is priority over roommate
- Roommate selection process occurs June
- Select roommate who is assigned to same hall, living experience & room type

Option 3:

Roommate(s) assigned by University Housing

- University Housing to assign the roommate based on living preference answers in the application
- Students who do not participate in Options 1 or 2, or miss the deadlines

Roommate Selection Portal Process



- Email reminder before process starts
- Log in to your MyCULiving portal
- Fill out your roommate profile
- Same hall, room type.



For students assigned to a double, community bath room type

- **June 9-15: Kittredge Community**

- 9 a.m. (MT) opening: Buckingham and Smith Halls
- Noon (MT) opening: Arnett and Andrews Halls
- 3 p.m. (MT) opening: Kittredge Central and Kittredge West Halls



For students assigned to a double, community bath room type

- **June 16-22: Central Campus Community**

- 9 a.m. (MT) opening: Baker, Aden and Cheyenne Arapaho Halls
- Noon (MT) opening: Hallett, Brackett and Libby Halls
- 3 p.m. (MT) opening: Willard, Cockerell and Sewall Halls



For students assigned to a double, community bath room type

- **June 23-29: Williams Village Community**

- 9 a.m. (MT) opening: Darley North and Williams Village North Halls
- Noon (MT) opening: Stearns East and Stearns West Halls
- 3 p.m. (MT) opening: Darley South and Onizuka Halls



Roommate Selection Portal Process



- Mutual –You both have to request and say yes!
- Confirmation emails
- If you have any issues, reach out immediately
- Confirmation of roommate matches will be released in the final emails on July 13, 14, and 15



Special Room Types



- If you have identified a roommate you would like to live with who has been assigned to your same building and room type (not double with community bath):
- You and your identified roommate must both email universityhousing@colorado.edu requesting to live with each other.



Special Room Types



- Emails will be accepted June 9 - 30.
- Some of our special room types are unique, with only one or two of these rooms in a building. Therefore, not all special room types are eligible to participate in the roommate selection process.

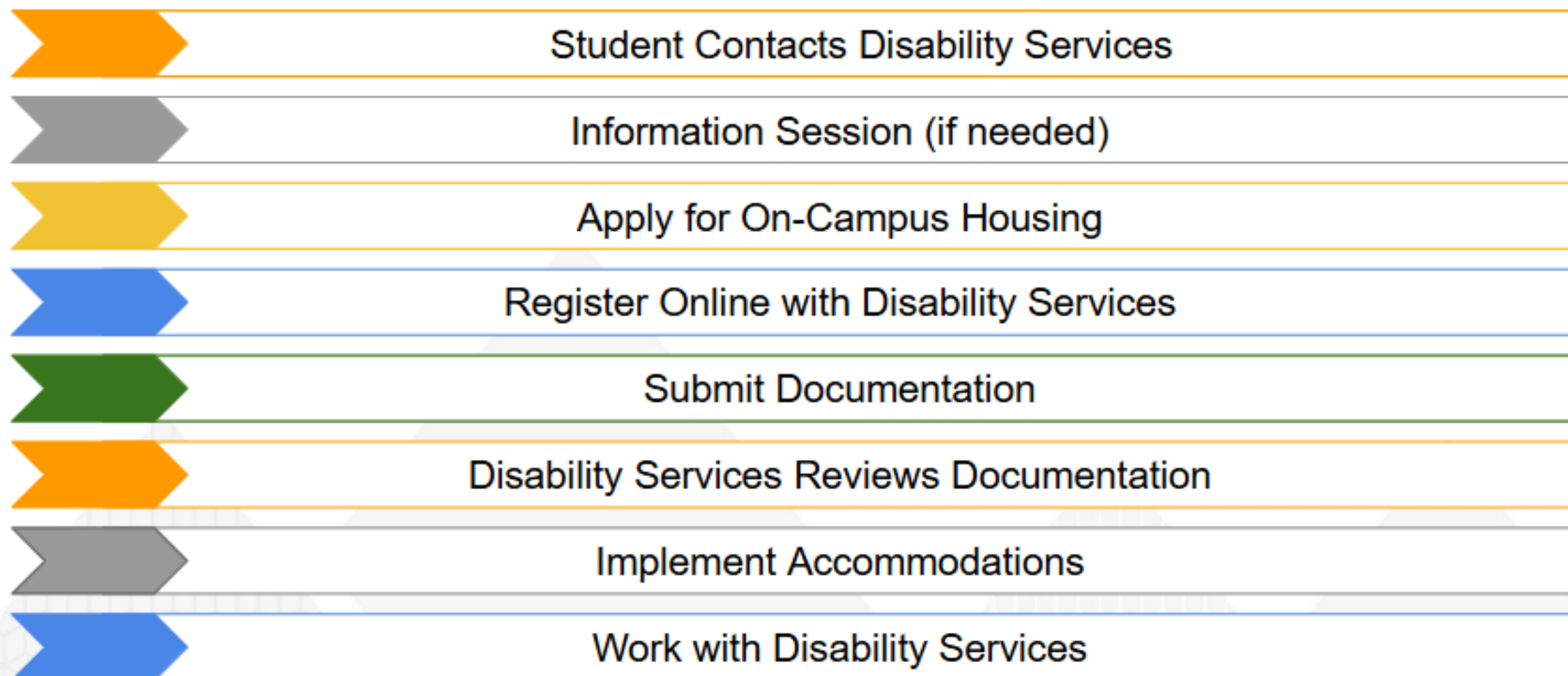


Housing Accommodations



- Medical or disability accommodations via Disability Services.

 - Please submit accommodation requests by April 20. Requests received after this date will still be reviewed, though placement options may be limited based on availability.

Selecting a Move-In Appointment

- All residents are required to schedule a move-in appointment.
- Appointment self-selection varies by community and begins on Tuesday, June 9. All appointments must be selected by July 14, 2026 at 11:59 p.m.
- All appointments will be self-selected through the students MyCULiving portal.
 - Look for a 'move-in appointments' button in the top, gold bar. (Or use the hamburger menu to locate the 'move-in appointments' button.)
- There are a designated number of appointments per timeslot. Once all appointments have been selected at that time, you will no longer be able to select those.



Selecting a Move-In Appointment

 - 3 p.m. | Bear Creek and Code Talker Hall
 - **June 10, 2026**

 - 1 p.m. | Stearns East and Stearns West
 - 2 p.m. | Williams Village North and Darley North
 - 3 p.m. | Onizuka

Selecting a Move-In Appointment

 - 1 p.m. | Aden, Brackett, Cockerell, Crossman and Reed
 - 2 p.m. | Libby and Cheyenne Arapaho

Drop Off Day | August 11

- Tuesday, August 11
- Optional opportunity for students/families to place items directly in your student's room before move-in begins
 - *Due to summer school housing and summer construction projects, Drop-Off Day appointments are not available to students living in Arnett, Bear Creek, Code Talker or Weber Hall.*
- \$20 fee added to your students Bursars account
- On Drop Off Day, you will not be able to unpack or decorate. Items need to remain boxed/packaged.
- Student must be present for the entire drop off



Pre-Arrival Programs

- Pre-arrival Programs offer students the opportunity to move in early and meet people who share similar interests.
- Priority application deadline: June 10
- Final deadline of July 8
- Pre-arrival program students move-in on Friday, August 15
- Apply at: <https://www.colorado.edu/orientation/pre-arrival-programs>
- Examples:
 - Mind & Body Buffs: focused on Well-being
 - Stampede camp: focused on student leadership
 - EcoReps: Focused on Sustainability
 - SkoServe: Focused on volunteer service

 - Mail items to yourself via the UPS Store.
 - Items must be RECEIVED by August 1st and will be placed in your student's room.
 - You do not need to know your address or room number to use this program.

- **Online ordering:**
 - If ordering items online, you DO need to know your mailbox number- which you will get in late July.
 - We can begin receiving packages on/after August 10th.
 - Items received before August 10th will be rejected/returned
