Job Qualifications / Requirements: Throughout the course of the internship, participants will be asked to handle a wide variety of duties essential to the legislative process. Candidates should have excellent writing and communication skills, strong organizational abilities, a strong interest in Colorado politics and public policy.

- Assisting with outreach efforts
- Conducting research on specific issues or legislation
- Monitoring and reporting on committee meetings for legislators and staff
- Summarizing reports or bills
- Researching and drafting responses to constituent inquiries
- Assisting with e-mail, mail and telephone contacts
- Other administrative work such as data entry, filings, preparing mailings, etc.
- A basic knowledge of Microsoft Office software
- Legislative interns must be able to adapt quickly in a fast-paced environment and work well without direct supervision

Credit/Compensation

Interns are expected to work at least 5-10 hours per week from January to May 2019. Interim interns (June to December of 2018) are also taken on a case-by-case basis. Interns are unpaid volunteers. However, student internship credit can be arranged with your school.
