About Jena:

In 2018, Jena Griswold was the first Democrat to win the Colorado Secretary of State race since the 1950s and won with an eight percent victory margin. In 2019, Griswold worked with the legislature to pass campaign finance reform, automatic voter registration, and the Colorado Votes Act, which added polling locations and mail ballot drop boxes across the state, guaranteeing them on all public universities and tribal lands. In 2020, the Secretary of State was the leading advocate in expanding mail ballots nationwide. In 2021, Griswold was elected as the chair of the Democratic Association of Secretaries of State.

This internship will be based out of Denver, Colorado; however, due to COVID, most work can and will be performed remotely from home. An intern can expect and should be able to work independently to complete tasks in a fast-paced environment. The intern will need to be flexible and able to perform a wide range of tasks/hold various responsibilities including data entry, conducting research, help with communications including social media and digital advertising, conducting outreach, recruiting volunteers, and more.
