Legislative Aide, Colorado Senate Republicans

A Legislative Aide in the Colorado General Assembly is essentially the legislator's personal staff. An Aide works with one legislator. An Aide handles all aspects of the legislator's office – phone, e-mail, calendar, schedule meetings with stakeholders, constituent service, bill research, etc. A senior Aide may also supervise a junior Aide as well as interns.

This is a full-time position (40 hours per week) during the legislative session (January 9 – May 8). This is not a year-round position, however, opportunities to extend the service time exist. Compensation is \$20/hour with insurance benefits and enrollment in PERA, the state's pension program.

The position of Legislative Aide can be the beginning of a career in government whether at the staff level, departmental level, lobbying or, perhaps, elected official. Please, send your resume to:
