PSCI 3301 Gender and Sexuality in U.S. Law – Vanessa Baird

This class is being taught as a hybrid remote/online class. In this class, we will meet Monday, Wednesday, and Friday synchronously via Zoom during the scheduled class time to discuss the readings and material. Students are encouraged to attend these sessions, but attendance is not necessarily required. I will post the lectures to the syllabus, and students are responsible for understanding the material in the lectures. Students are expected to complete the readings before watching the lectures. Students will get credit for group work, participating in weekly online Canvas discussions, and doing reading and lecture quizzes from time to time. This class has two online exams which are conducted online, but there are also pre-exam quizzes to ensure you understand the material. Pre-exam quizzes test for knowledge; exams are much more difficult and test for the ability to deal with the material creatively and critically. They are open note, open book, open internet, NOT open discussion. There is NO in-person component to this class.
