- Conducting and assembling research to support legislative efforts.
- Tracking implementation process of laws.
- Assisting community advocates to engage with the legislative process.

- Analytical skills/thinking.
- Community and equity minded.
- Strong interest in advancing economic security legislation.
- Ability to successfully manage multiple projects.
- Collaborative, team player, communicates well.

This is a paid position of \$22 an hour beginning in December or early January and concluding in May (5-6 months) with an expectation of 25-30 hours a week either remote or in our office located in downtown Denver near the Colorado State Capitol.
