



Job Description: Intern

Roles/Duties:

- Recruit, train, and manage volunteers for canvassing, phone banking, and community events.
- Must be able to hit metric goals on a weekly basis and work well under pressure.
- Provide daily/weekly reports of voter contact and volunteer recruitment data.
- Staff events in different roles as directed (sign-in table, preparation/take down, etc.)
- Plan and recruit for weekly volunteer events in your respective counties.
- Canvassing on weekends leading up to the election
- Work with other Field Organizers, candidates, campaign staff, and organizations (labor unions) across the district to implement a successful field program.
- Other duties as directed by the Campaign Manager.

Job Requirements:

- Prior organizing experience is ideal but not required (paid, volunteer, or internship).
- Availability through June 6th for potential runoff election (initial general election takes place April 4th).
- Full availability for the last two weekends before an Election is required.
- Access to a reliable vehicle. Travel is required.
- Must be a strong trainer.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to work well with a team.
- Weekend availability.
- Commitment to the cause of re-electing Chris Hinds to Denver City Council.
