

PSCI 2106-001 Introduction to Public Policy Analysis- Billica

This class is being taught as a hybrid in-person/remote class. Half of the students will be assigned to attend class on Tuesday and half to attend on Thursday. On the day when you are not in class, you should plan to join in synchronously via Zoom during the scheduled class time. Students are expected to regularly attend and participate in class lecture and discussion, both in-person and remote. Participation is a graded component of the class, measured by attendance, submissions to the class discussion board on Canvas, and participation in optional active discussion sessions during posted office hours. This class has two take-home essay exams and a final paper. The in-person component of the class will change only if the instructor becomes ill, or the class or campus are directed to change modality due to public health concerns. Students who are ill or who are required to quarantine or temporarily isolate will be accommodated but should otherwise plan to attend class as scheduled. Scheduled class sessions will be recorded and posted to Canvas for any who are unable to attend a particular class session.
