

PSCI 3054-001 American Political Thought- Donavan

This class is being taught as a hybrid in-person/online class. Half of the class will be assigned to attend class on Tuesday and half to attend on Thursday. We will cover the same material in both the Tuesday and Thursday in-person sessions. In lieu of the day students are not scheduled to attend, they are expected to watch 3-5 short recorded lectures. Students may choose to watch these at any time during the week as they are asynchronous. Students are expected to attend class regularly and participate, and attendance and participation are graded components of the class. Students cannot Zoom in to in-person sessions and the in-person sessions will not be recorded. There is also an opportunity to receive participation credit by participating in Canvas discussions and students are encouraged to participate in the online discussions regularly. This class has two essay exams which are conducted as take-home exams. The class also has a final paper. Students who are ill, or required to quarantine or isolate temporarily will be accommodated with alternate work, but there is NO fully remote/online option to this class. The in-person component of the class will change only if the instructor becomes ill, the class or the campus are directed to change modality, or public health orders require a change of modality.
