

PSCI 3183-001 International Law- Shannon

This class is being taught as a hybrid online/remote class, and there are no in-person meetings. Monday and Wednesday meetings each week will occur synchronously, during the regularly scheduled class meeting time, with live discussions over Zoom. Students are expected to regularly attend and participate in the synchronous meetings. The synchronous meetings will not be recorded, so as to foster the ability of students to speak freely during the discussions. Many of the discussions will occur in small breakout sessions. On Fridays we will not meet synchronously. Instead, students will view pre-recorded lectures and participate in discussion boards and questions on Canvas. Graded components of the class include two at-home written exams (a midterm and a final). The class also includes several short written papers. Finally, an international law simulation will take place over Zoom towards the end of the semester, and students will write a paper to prepare for the simulation.
