- -Documenting attendance and providing reports to CUUB directors as needed.

The academic year advisor will be responsible for-

- -Developing a college-going, study skill, or life skill presentation/activity (15-20 mins) and provide presentation to students via zoom
- -Documenting attendance and providing reports to CUUB directors as needed.
