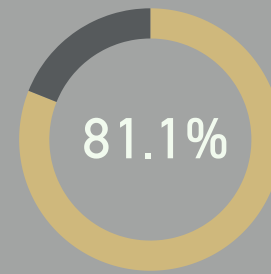
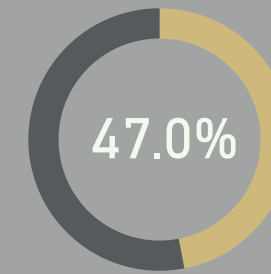

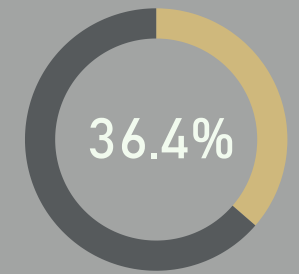

% Of international students



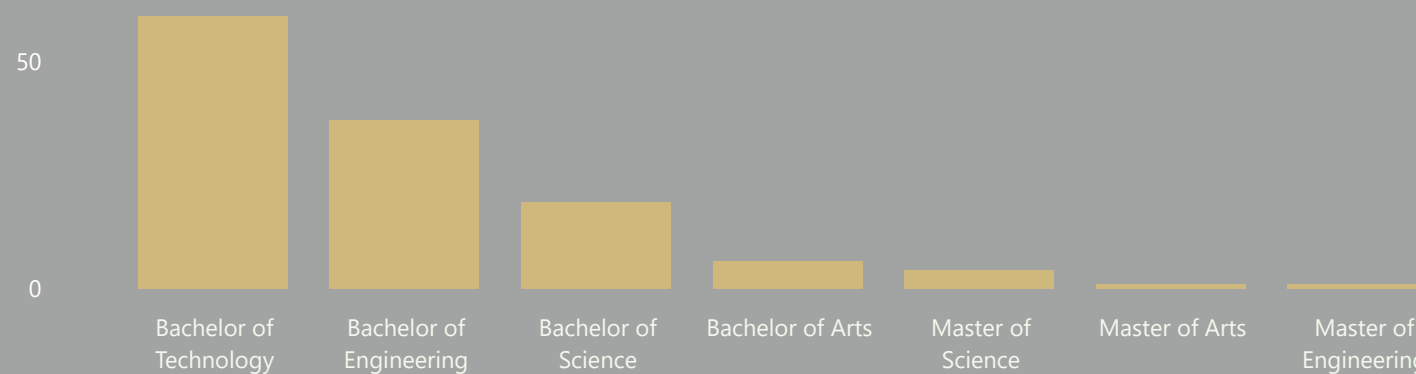
% Of students with prior work experience

Students' background degree

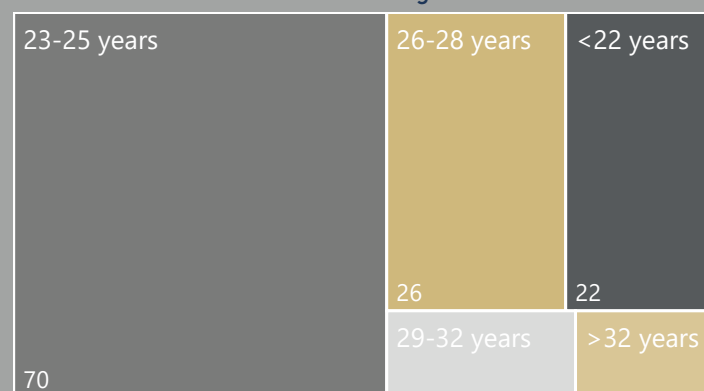

Building a strong community

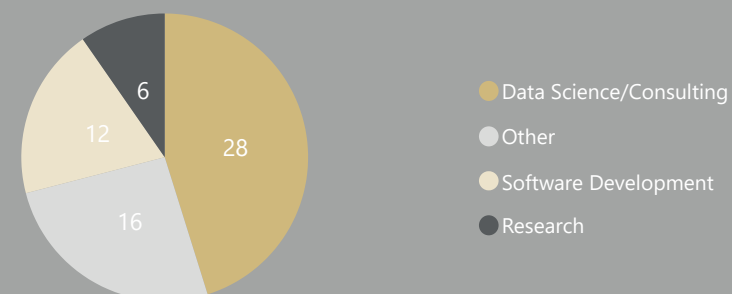
- We admitted 55 students in our first year, and followed that by admitting 77 students in our second year
- Our students have a median TOEFL score of 102 and median duolingo score of 125
- We do have students with an active military background
- Mean GPA of our admitted students is 3.41, with maximum of 4 and minimum of 3.05
- 62% of the students in the annual survey ranked the program to be 'very good' and 'meeting expectations'

Students' age



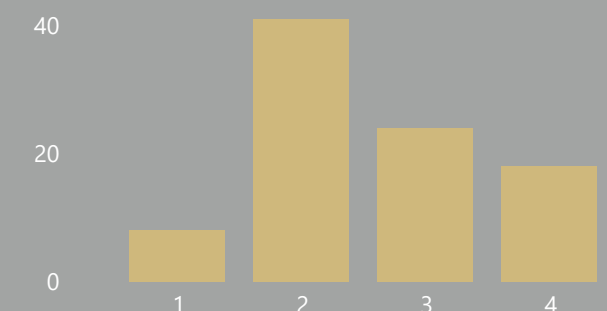
