

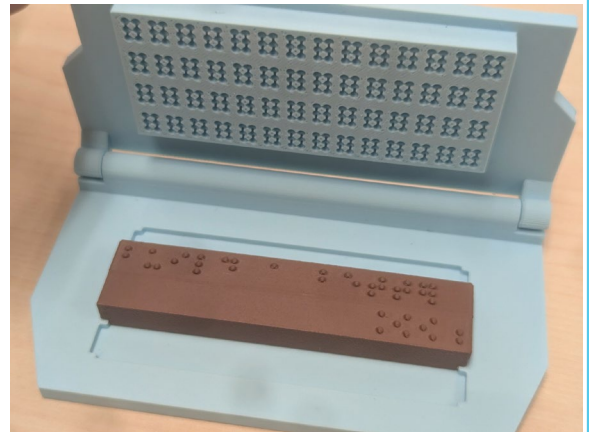


Braille Embosser

OBJECTIVE: Use a 3D-printed braille embosser to create text in braille.

SET UP:

- Open the embosser and ensure that the text blocks are oriented correctly. Do they "read" like braille should?



STEPS:

- Place a sheet of paper or a bookmark on top of the side of the embosser with the holes, and then close the embosser, pressing firmly!
- Remove the sheet of paper and see if the braille was transferred successfully to the paper.
- Use the braille alphabet chart to de-code the braille. What does it say?
- What are some potential uses / applications for this type of embosser?
