

The imperial Achaemenid coinage (daric/siglos) is very consistent through all 200 years of the empire, probably in part to retain the recognizability of the coins. Various cities or satrapies in the western parts of the empire minted coins during the Achaemenid period (let alone after) that were distinct from the imperial issues, however. These often did change with time.

Pick one coin (or two, if you have time). What is its imagery (obv/rev)? Where was it minted?

Find one reference/resource to the coin (check books, <https://greekcoinage.org/arch/>; <http://www.greekcoinage.org/>; <https://www.corpus-nummorum.eu>). See if it turns up on the coinboards.org map. Check Anson to find other instances of coins with related imagery.
