- 2. The application should also contain a one-page statement of the candidate's plan for graduate training, and a subsequent career in psychology.
- 3. In addition, the applicant should obtain at least two letters of reference from psychology faculty members familiar with the candidate's work.
- 4. Finally, the applicant should submit a written sample of laboratory or library research in psychology based upon completed or ongoing work.

The Psychology Department Awards Committee will select the recipient. The student will receive the award at the May 2014 Department ceremony for graduating students, which will be held on the evening of Thursday, May 8.
