Lecturers

The Department of Psychology and Neuroscience hires lecturers to teach on a course-by-course basis when additional offerings of courses is needed. The title Lecturer (job code 1419) is granted to a scholar invited to the University to give lectures or perform other teaching duties. The lecturer should possess the same qualifications as regular faculty members. More information on lecturers can be found on the Arts & Sciences website.

Compensation for Lecturers in Psychology & Neuroscience is determined by the College of Arts and Sciences Level C policy as stated here.

3-credit course: \$7,585
