## Main differences between NIH and NSF fellowship awards:

## NIH (National Research Service Award -NRSA)

- Funding comes directly from the sponsor through CU Boulder
- Award and speedtype is set up through OCG
- Monthly stipend amount is set by NIH
  - o \$25,320/year (\$2110.00/month paid over 12 months)\*
- 3 years of financial support within 5 years
  - o Possible to delay a year if needed
- Pays 60% of full-time CU Boulder tuition/fees/insurance
  - o \$8134 per year\*\*
- Award gives an institutional allowance of \$4,200.00/year
  - o In addition to the monthly stipend
  - o May be used for research needs and/or insurance costs
  - o Leftover funds do not carry forward year to year
- May request approval from NIH to hold an additional TA or GRA appointment
  - o Max 25% additional appointment per semester fall, spring and summer
  - OCG (irina.rastello@colorado.edu) will contact sponsor for approval
  - o Can help off-set tuition/fees/insurance expenses not covered by the award
    - See calculations spreadsheet to determine what an additional % appointment will cover
- Appointment housed and administered in Psychology & Neuroscience Department (10190)
  - o Department will set up the appointment in the HR system
  - o Department will process tuition award amount
  - o Department will assist with policies/procedures on spending the institutional allowance
  - o Contact your business office professional with any questions

## NSF (Graduate Research Fellowship Program - GRFP)

- Funding comes directly from CU Boulder through the Graduate School
- Award and speedtype is set up through the Graduate School
- Monthly stipend is set by the Graduate School
  - \$34,000/year (2833.33/month paid over 12 months)\*
- 3 years of financial support within 5 year period
  - o possible to delay a year if needed
- \$12,000 allowance for tuition and fees
  - o covers full tuition/fees and insurance costs
- May request approval from the Graduate School to hold an additional TA or GRA appointment
  - o Max 25% additional appointment per semester fall, spring and summer
  - o Contact Patricia Stansfield (patricia.stansfield@colorado.edu) for approval
- Appointment housed and administered in the Graduate School (10556)
  - o Graduate School will set up the appointment in the HR system
  - o Graduate School will process tuition award amount
  - o Contact Patricia Stansfield or your business office professional with any questions
- \* Current 2020-2021 (AY) monthly stipend amounts subject to change if the sponsor or grad school gives a cost of living increase
