IM Policy

For participation in Equal Opportunity Leagues, there are no gender-specific requirements. For participation in Co-Rec Leagues, gender-specific requirements are based off the sport's specific participation number requirements (found in the sport-specific rule set) and individuals may participate in accordance with their gender identity. Non-binary participants are not required to gender declare and their participation will count towards the larger gender requirement needed for the team (ie: Co-Rec basketball requires no more than three of a gender and no less than two of the other on the court at a time, a non-binary participant would count toward the no more than three gender requirement). Misuse of this policy may result in forfeiture of game and/or season.

Gender expression and gender identity are protected under the University of Colorado Boulder's antidiscrimination policy.

Club Transgender and Non-Binary Participant Policy

Internal participation within the University of Colorado's Sport Club Program (be on a team's roster, practice, etc.) for transgender athletes will be permitted in accordance with an athlete's gender identity. Non-binary athletes are not required to gender identify and may participate internally with the club of their choice. External participation for transgender and non-binary athletes (competition, travel, etc.) will be determined by the club's respective National Governing Body and will supersede Sport Clubs' internal policies.

Locker Rooms

The University of Colorado Student Recreation Center provides gender-specific and all-gender restrooms and locker rooms which are available for use by Rec Center members.

Gender expression and gender identity are protected under the University of Colorado Boulder's antidiscrimination policy.

Gender-Specific Activities

For gender-specific activities provided by the University of Colorado Student Recreation Services, individuals may participate in accordance with their gender identity. Non-binary participants are not required to gender identify and may participate in all gender-specific activities.
