Course Fees

Accessing Campus Services

Continuing Education students may use campus libraries at no cost. To gain access, please obtain a "no fees paid" sticker (available at the Continuing Education cashier's desk) and bring the sticker and a photo ID with you when you plan to use libraries.

Optional Student Fees

Denver-metro area Continuing Education students who are enrolled for credit courses (excluding Summer Session courses) may elect to purchase an optional student fee package. Student fees are assessed based on the term in which you are enrolled.
