

Verification of Parent's Move to Colorado for Faculty Position

For Dependents of New Faculty at Colorado State-Supported Colleges and Universities

A **child dependent** is eligible for in-state tuition if the dependent moved to Colorado in the 12 months preceding enrollment because the student's parent or legal guardian moved to Colorado to take a paid faculty position at a state-supported institution of higher education.

Students qualifying for in-state tuition on this basis qualify for the <u>College Opportunity Fund</u> (which requires a separate application), but do not qualify for Colorado resident financial aid programs.

Instructions

Email, fax, mail or hand deliver the following required documentation to the Office of the Registrar by the close of business on the first day of class for the applicable term:

- 1. This form, completed and signed.
- 2. A copy of the parent's contract or offer of employment from a Colorado public college or university.
- 3. A copy of one of the following:
 - a. The parent's most recent paystub indicating Colorado state income tax witholding.
 - b. The parent's current faculty ID card.
