# Micro-credentials & Badges

- **Micro-credentials:** Short programs that allow students to gain industry-relevant skills and/or other competencies.
  - Smaller than certificates, which require a minimum of nine graduate credits or 12 undergraduate credits.
  - May be non-credit, credit-based, or a hybrid.
- **Badges:** A digital credential that may be displayed to demonstrate the achievement earned or complete through a micro-credential program.
- Credly/Acclaim platform
- Pilot programs out of Graduate School and Libraries
- Website, communication, proposal form...coming soon!

# Grade Replacement

## Fall 2019 numbers:

- 1,018 student requests submitted
- 937 students requests approved

## Deadlines:

- 16-week deadline: third Friday (census)
- Special sessions: add/drop with no record deadline
- Form does not allow late submissions.
- Students who miss the deadline can still repeat the course.

# Grade Replacement

## Next steps:

- Testing end-of-term setup and ensuring previous grade is removed from GPA
- Working with UIS on a few final customizations to validation process (eligibility check)
- Working on automation of processes
  - Running nightly
  - Generating targeted notifications to students
- Ongoing awareness-building communication in Spring 2020

# BAM Processes and Timelines

Students admitted as of July 1, 2019 follow the new Bachelor's–Accelerated Master's program structure.

- Students apply with intent form around the junior year.
  - Program decision for full BAM program at this point.
  - Students provide expected graduation term for bachelor's degree.
- Early in the semester in which bachelor's degree requirements are complete:
  - Students apply to graduate with bachelor's degree.
  - Students complete the master's continuation form. (No departmental review.)
- Students complete remaining requirements as a master's student.



# BAM Details and Next Steps

- Up to and including 12 credits taken as undergrad can be used toward master's degree
- Certain number of credits can double count toward the bachelor's and master's degrees
  - Program-specific, based upon approved concurrent degree proposal
- Students admitted prior to July 1 still follow the concurrent structure
- Working on processes for updating expected graduation term, discontinuation from BAM program, clarifying double-counting courses

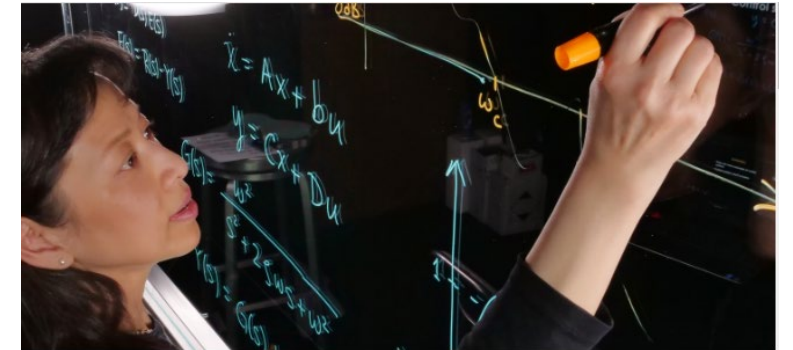
Fall 2019

## Program/Plan Proposals

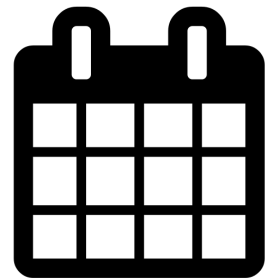
- Typically have a fall implementation

- Other proposals are dependent on college curriculum meeting schedules

## Catalog Updates (Annual Publication Cycle)

- Academic department review: Dec. 13, 2019
- College/school review: Feb. 7, 2020

## Degree Audit Updates

- Curriculum updates available June 1 (as entered in catalog)
- Based on fall effective dates
- Spring changes considered if no impacts on audit or student enrollments

# Class Search - Phase III

## Functional Improvements: Completed

- **Added class details:** campus, location and add consent
- **Location filter:** Main Campus, East Campus, Colorado Mesa, CU in DC, etc.
- **Combined career and upper/lower division**
- **Conditional filtering:** campus - session, gen. ed. - subject
- **Enhanced textbook display:** if course material information not available from bookstore, related link is hidden automatically

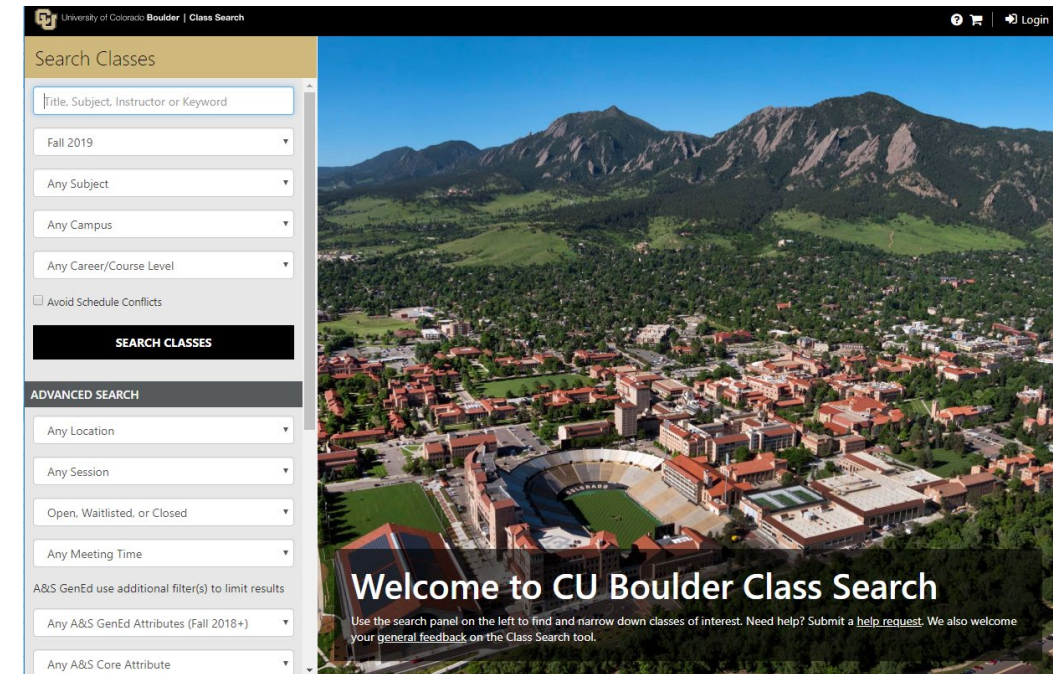

# XML Transcript Exchange Update

**Goal:** Implement data exchange between Colorado's institutions of higher education, namely between the community college system (CCCS) and volunteer four-year institutions.

**Who:** Grassroots effort by participating institutions.

**Why:**

- Enhance existing business processes that rely on paper and PDF transcripts
- Improve student service
- Reduce fraud

**Pilot:**

- **Send:** CCCS will begin to send PESC XML transcript
- **Receive:** four-year institutions receive PESC XML transcripts

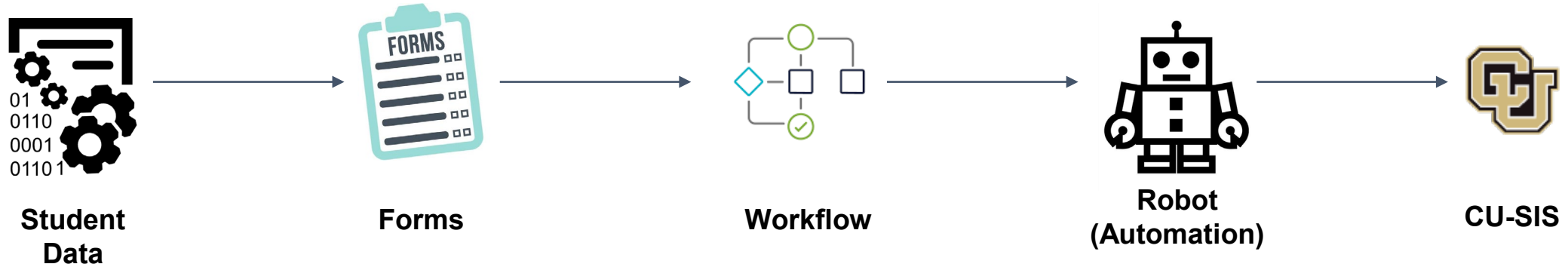

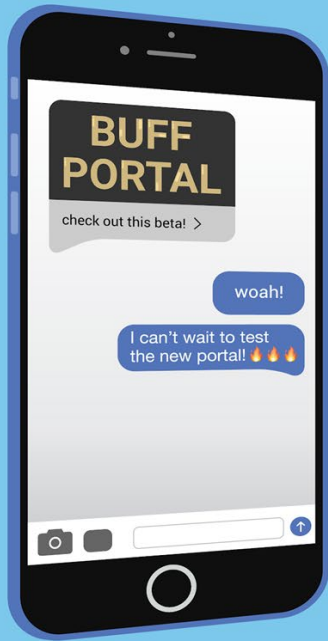

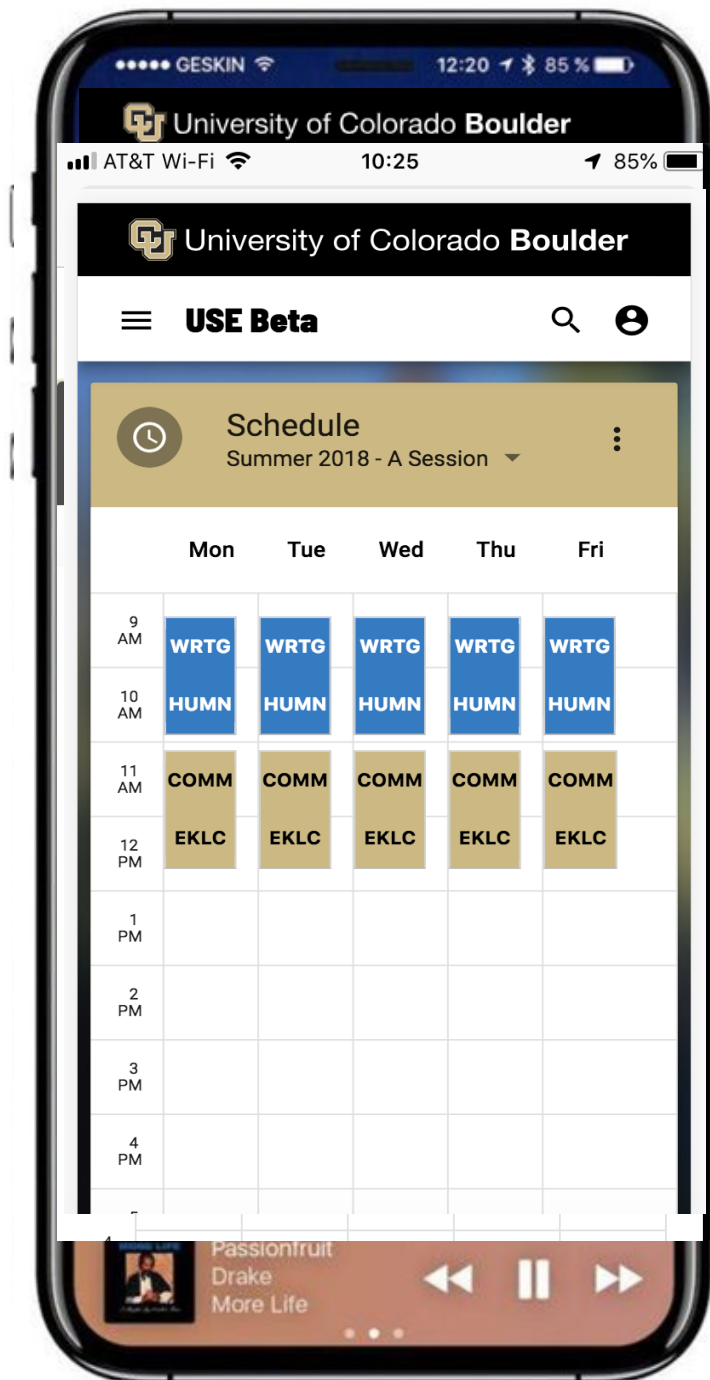

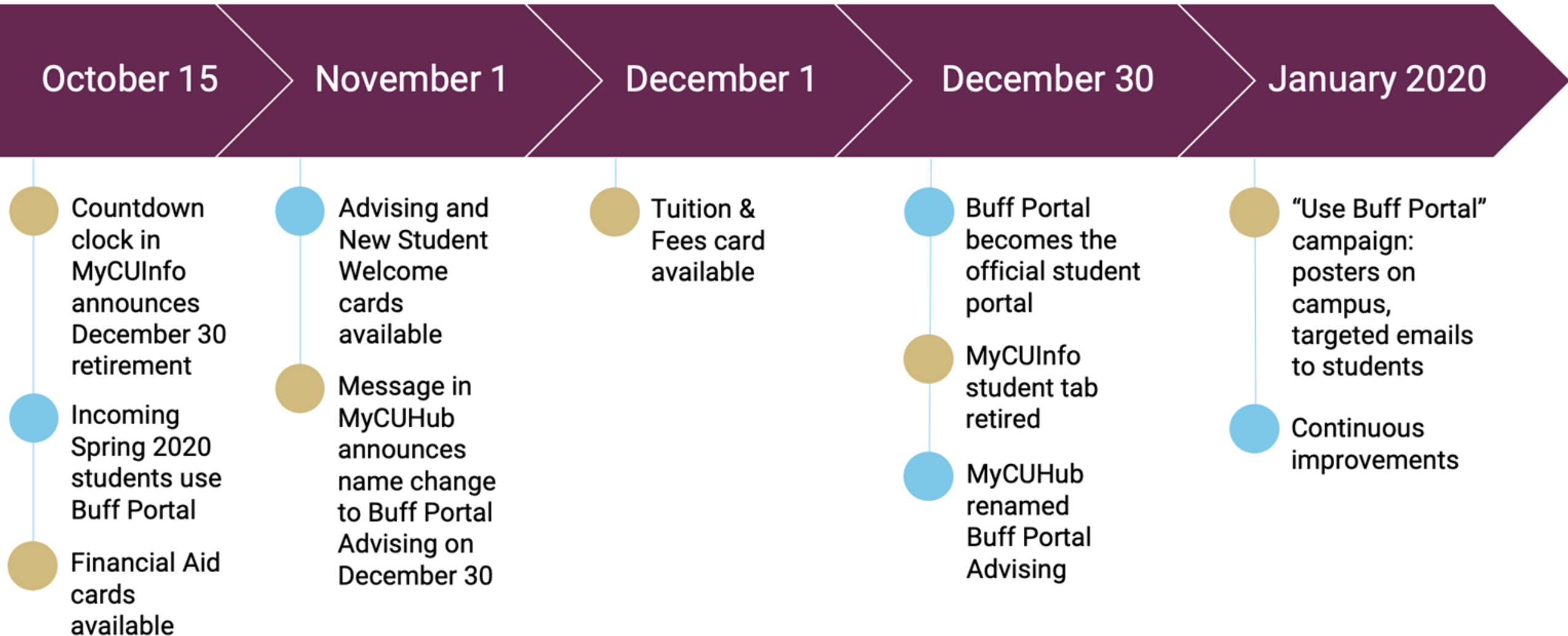
## Student Response
