All deadlines occur at 11:59 p.m. on the date listed unless otherwise noted.

Wednesday, September 10, 2014

- Last day to <u>drop a course</u> without tuition/fee charges and a W grade on your transcript.
- <u>Other events</u>: Last day to withdraw with only a \$200 processing fee, waive CUSG fees, and request a refund for student opportunity fees (5 p.m.).

Friday, September 12, 2014

• Last day to <u>add a course</u> and be eligible for <u>College Opportunity Fund (COF)</u> funding (5 p.m.).

• Last day to <u>change variable-credit hours</u>, <u>pass/fail assignment</u>, <u>and no-credit status</u> on courses without petitioning your dean.

Friday, October 31, 2014

- Last day to <u>drop a course</u> via <u>MyCUInfo</u> (full tuition and fees will be assessed, and a W grade will appear on your transcript). After this date, your instructor's and dean's signatures are required.
- Last day to make arrangements with your instructor to change your final exam schedule.

Monday, December 8, 2014

• Last day to add a course without your instructor's and dean's signatures (5 p.m.).
