Commencement Program & Ceremony Information (Graduation)

The final CU-Boulder winter commencement ceremony occurred on Dec. 19, 2015. The following policies have been changed to reflect CU-Boulder's spring-only commencement ceremonies:

- The Spring 2016 Commencement Program will include students who applied to graduate in Spring or Summer 2016 by the April 1 deadline. Students expecting to graduate in Fall 2016 are welcome to attend the Spring 2016 commencement ceremony, but their names will not appear in the Commencement Program until Spring 2017.
- The Spring 2017 Commencement Program will include Fall 2016 graduates and students who applied to graduate in Spring or Summer 2017 by the April 1 deadline. The program will denote the specific graduation term(s) for each student.

- Fall 2016 graduates may request a mailed hard copy of the Spring 2017 Commencement Program by sending an email request to diplomas@colorado.edu.
- Any student can attend the university commencement ceremony; there is no preregistration and no tickets are issued.
- Individual schools and colleges may hold departmental recognition ceremonies in December, if they choose.
- Beginning with Fall 2016 graduates, the Office of the Registrar will publish a list of graduates on our website after degrees are officially conferred each semester (i.e., names of Fall 2016 graduates will be published in early February 2017).
