To change your graduation date, see <u>Apply for Graduation</u> and follow steps 1–3 (select **Fall 2016** as your graduation term to modify your application).

Deadlines occur at 11:59 p.m. Mountain Time unless otherwise noted.

Friday, Dec. 9 – Graduation Application Deadline for Undergraduate Students

This is the last day for undergraduate students to submit, update or cancel a Fall 2016 graduation application in <u>MyCUInfo</u>. Note: This deadline was Saturday, Oct. 1, for graduate students, and Tuesday, Nov. 1, for MBA and law students.

Thursday, Dec. 15 – Fall 2016 Degree Conferral

Degrees are conferred on this date. There is no official campuswide commencement ceremony, but some colleges, schools and programs host recognition ceremonies. Visit <u>Winter Department Recognition Ceremonies</u> for more information.

Thursday, Jan. 19 - Deadline to Update Diploma Name and Address in MyCUInfo

In MyCUInfo, click **Apply for Graduation** and follow the prompts until you see your name and address listed, and edit them there. If you do not enter a Diploma Address, your diploma will be mailed to your Home Address. While you're there, confirm that your other addresses are correct too.

Monday, Jan. 30 - Degrees Post to Transcripts (5 p.m.)

Transcripts can be <u>ordered online</u> as long as you don't have a financial hold. Send questions to <u>transcriptinfo@colorado.edu</u>.

Friday, Feb. 17 – Diplomas Mailed to Students AND CeDiplomas Available for Purchase and Download If you did not enter a Diploma Address in <u>MyCUInfo</u>, your diploma will be mailed to your Home Address. <u>Certified</u> <u>electronic diplomas</u> can be reserved any time, but will be available for purchase and download on and after this date.
