- Faculty Network ➤ Build a network with faculty leaders and peers from across campus.
- Workshops ➤ Priority workshop registration.
- Strategic Career and Research Coaching ➤ One-on-one coaching on strategies to develop your individual research, scholarly or creative work plan.
- Identify Funding ➤ One-on-one assistance in identifying relevant funding opportunities.
- Get to Know Campus Leaders ➤ Roundtable discussions with campus leaders; past sessions have included the Provost, Vice Chancellor for Research & Innovation and Associate Deans for Research.
