

RETIRED FACULTY RESEARCH & CREATIVE WORKS AWARDS FOR
UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO – BOULDER FACULTY RETIREES

The University of Colorado Boulder Retired Faculty Association (UCBRFA) is pleased to call for applications for awards up to \$2,000 to aid in conducting new or continuing research projects carried out by UCB faculty retirees. The Chancellor has generously made funds available for this program, recognizing the continuing research contributions of UCB retirees to their fields and to the reputation of the university.

The UCBRFA Research Awards Committee will consider the originality, significance, and feasibility of the research. The awards cannot be used to support an applicant's salary or as reimbursement for past expenditures. Recipients of past grants may apply for further support but only after a year has elapsed since the satisfactory completion of all award requirements from their previous award. Priority will be given to proposals that involve UCB students.

UCB Retired faculty wishing to be considered should submit an electronic application to the Chair of the Committee, James Alleman <james.alleman@colorado.edu>.

Applications will be accepted through April 27, 2025, and awards will be announced by June 2, 2025, with funds awarded subsequently. Award funds must be expended within one year. Awardees are expected to provide a brief (approximately 3-pages maximum) final report to the Grants Committee by August 17, 2026, unless other arrangements are mutually agreed upon. In addition, awardees must agree to have their project information published on the UCBRFA website as well as to provide, if requested, a research presentation at a UCBRFA meeting.

Please include in your application:

- A cover page with Project Title and the applicant's name, former and current university affiliation, date of retirement, email address, and physical contact address including phone number(s).
- An abstract limited to 150 words describing the major objectives of the work.
- A description of the project, its purpose, and the expected outcomes, not to exceed two pages/single-spaced/size 12 font.
- A budget indicating intended uses of the award funds.
- A brief CV not to exceed two pages.
