

THE UCB RETIRED FACULTY ASSOCIATION December 21, 2020 Update

Dear Colleagues,

As indicated in our July 5, 2020 update, the COVID-19 crisis did put our plans for 2020 on hold. We had anticipated offering a Fall 2020 schedule of events, but circumstances did not allow us to do this in the manner anticipated. However, we used the time to expand the UCBRFA "transitional" executive committee¹ to provide creative approaches to the COVID-19 limitations. Based on the efforts of the committee members, we are pleased to report that the UCBRFA has a full slate of events planned for the Spring 2021 semester. The website also provides useful information regarding resources as well as other items of interest for campus retirees.

 Distinguished Faculty Seminar Series: We are inviting distinguished faculty members on the Boulder campus to give presentations based on their and their students' scholarly work. The objective is to provide audiences with a knowledge of faculty commitments to research, instruction, and student mentoring and the value of their studies to our society. The first virtual seminar will be presented by Professor Daniel Baker, the Director of the Laboratory for Atmospheric and Space Physics (LASP), on Wednesday, January 20th at 4:00PM (MST). His seminar will be held virtually via Zoom.

A second presentation will be given by Professor David Korevaar from the College of Music, at a date in February to be announced. Kim Malville and Bob Grossman are coordinating this series. Additional presentations are scheduled for March, April and May. In addition to retirees, this series will be available to active faculty, students, CU administrators, alumni, members of the Board of Regents, and Boulder community members.

- **Research Award Program:** UCBRFA will be seeking proposals in support of retiree research and scholarly work. Further details about this research award program (including proposal guidelines, deadlines, and levels of financial support) will be announced in the near future. The resources available for the year 2021 will enable a CU system-wide competition as well as one for Boulder campus retirees only. Jim Alleman will coordinate this program.
- **Discussion Group series:** Professor Allan Franklin will facilitate a series of discussion groups based on scholarly topics with assigned readings as well as issues of overall importance to retirees. It is anticipated that the first of these discussions will occur in February, again more details soon to follow.
- **Opportunities to mentoring elementary school students participating in a science fair:** The PTO of the Douglas Elementary School in Boulder, Jan Cartwright, has requested mentoring assistance for students participating in a science fair. She states, "The students' curiosity is a highlight of the fair for me. For example, one year, my daughter's project was; *Are rabbits right-pawed or left-pawed?* since she noticed that the tracks in the snow varied. Another student, whose family owns a farm, created a goat-powered generator!" If you are
