



- Mission:** The Roser Visiting Artist Endowment was established to enrich the lives and education of students and community members at the University of Colorado at Boulder in music, theatre and dance, fine arts and film studies, by funding visiting professional artists who have a demonstrated record of excellence and a commitment to working with students. This enrichment and interaction will be fostered by the Artists' collaboration in the creative process with students and faculty.
- Purpose:** To provide funds to bring nationally and internationally accomplished artists in the fine and performing arts to the University of Colorado at Boulder. The grant will provide guest lectureships, workshops, performances, directorships, exhibitions, as well as other art-related programs which will benefit students, faculty, and the community as a whole.
- Evaluation Criteria:** Proposals will be awarded to support artistically excellent visitors who will have a broad impact on the students.
- Schedules:** **Grant proposals** are due in November (see website for date) each year and are distributed for use the following academic year (ex: grants due Nov 2012 were for AY13-14). Final reports to be submitted within two months of completion of project.
- Mini-grant proposals** are accepted year-round and are distributed per calendar year. No final report required.
- Send to:** **Grant proposals** must be e-mailed to the current Roser Fellow (contact information available on Roser Grant website) **on or before 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date**. Applicants can expect to hear results within 12 weeks after deadline. All funded activities must take place during the academic year.
- Mini-grant proposals** should be mailed or e-mailed to: Nada Diachenko, Chair of the Roser Visiting Artist Endowment Committee, University of Colorado at Boulder, Campus Box 261, Boulder, CO 80309-0261 or nada.diachenko@colorado.edu. Applicants can expect to hear results within 3-4 weeks after they apply. Mini-grant requests cannot exceed \$1,000. No final report needed.

- Exclusions:** Roser Visiting Artist Program Grants will **NOT support fundraising activities, deficit reduction, receptions, marketing or publicity expenses**.
